Porphyria, fortunately, is a fairly rare disease. It is due to a chemical defect in the body, a defect which interferes with the body's mechanism for handling and getting rid of substances called porphyrins. These people often suffer much nervousness; they may get spells of abdominal pain, and sometimes the skin of their arms is so sensitive to light that in summer it actually ulcerates. The great danger that people who suffer from porphyria run is that some of them might operate on a patient under sodium penthal anesthesia. This could throw them

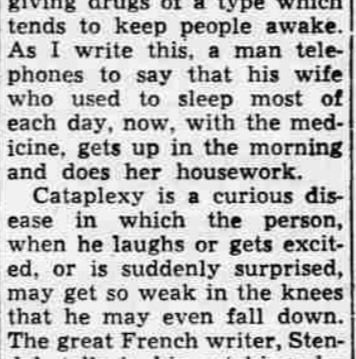

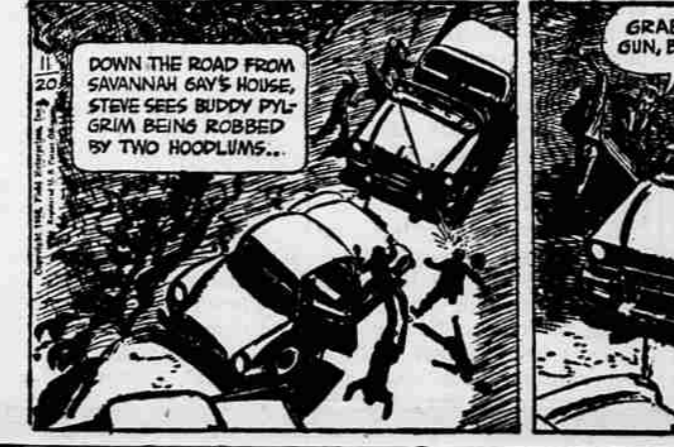
