

Lakes Lose Names By Federal Order

Lake City, Colo. — (UPI) — A half-dozen lakes near Steam-gulion Pass in southwest Colorado have been stripped of their names by federal order.

The lakes were built five years ago by Lake City developer Perk Vickers, who promised to name them after anyone who donated at least \$100 for the project.

So there was Lake Elizabeth Zirkle, Lake Slug Stuart, Lake Hildegarde Wupperman, Lake Frank Walker, Lake Emery Carper and Lake Pat Maloney.

But the U.S. Forest Service informed Vickers that this is illegal — that lakes can be named only after dead persons or Presidents of the U.S.

The Medical Roundup

Emphysema

Hundreds of people ask me what to do about emphysema, and I'm sorry I cannot give them a simple answer. In this disease, thousands of the little air sacs in the lung have ruptured, one into the other, and as a result, the lungs are no longer able to aerate the blood as efficiently as they should do. Many people probably were born to have emphysema, and others have developed it in the course of a lifetime of asthma.

Many have what we call a "barrel chest" where the muscles that run down the sides of the neck are contracted. These people always have trouble getting their breath because their lungs are always expanded as far as possible. Many of these people are always wheezing a bit. For some, every breath taken means an effort. Often I can recognize one of these persons at a glance by the anxious look on his perhaps slightly bluish face. It is bluish because the blood is not as red as it should be; it hasn't been well aerated.

Naturally, one cannot give such a man back good and normal lungs. Many of these people could probably help themselves a bit by quitting heavy smoking, and some in the earlier years could have been helped by someone who could have taught them how to avoid attacks of asthma.

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I had the disease I would go to some big medical center where I might find an expert on the handling of this disease. The problem is such a difficult one that even an internist like me does not know how to study the patient or to help him much.
