Humphrey in Moscow For Three-Day Visit

Moscow — (UPI) — Sen. Hubert Humphrey (D-Minn.), arrived in Moscow today for a three-day visit.

He had been in Geneva as congressional advisor to the U.S. delegation participating in the nuclear weapons talks and subsequently visited Berlin.

Special Award Due Neuberger

Eugene — (UPI) — Sen. Richard L. Neuberger (D-Ore.) will be honored with a special award at the annual convention of the Izaak Walton division here Saturday.

The award is for two conservation achievements considered outstanding in the past year.

Neuberger led the drive in Congress to amend the Klamath Indian termination act to permit harvesting of yellow pine on a sustained basis so the Upper Klamath marsh could be preserved as a national wildlife refuge.

The senator also was instrumental in securing passage of the Outdoor Recreational Resource Review act.

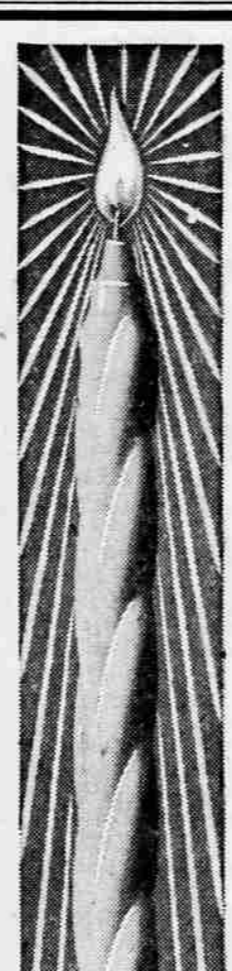
