SECTION 1. That there is hereby

held on the 10th day of December,
1958 for the purpose of submitting
to the legal voters of the said city
a proposed act of municipal
legislation as hereinafter set forth,
and said election is hereby ordered
and caused to be held on the above
date between the hours of one
o'clock P.M. and eight o'clock P.M.

SECTION 2. That each of the fol-
lowing wards within the City of Med-
ford, as designated by Ordinance
No. 6514 pursuant to Section 2 of the
City Charter, is hereby de-
clared to be and is established as
a polling place for the purpose
of said election, and the follow-
ing polling places are hereby
designated within the said city and
within said precincts, at which said elec-
tion shall be held:

Second Ward Menlo High School

SECTION 4. That each of said
judges of election shall be paid
the sum of \$2.00 for the services
as such, and shall be sworn to,
and shall conduct said elections
in the respective polling places
nearly as practicable in accordance
with the general laws of the State
of Oregon, and shall file their
reports on initiative measures, except
as otherwise prescribed in the City
Charter, No. 2688, as amended.

SECTION 5. That notice of said
special election shall be given by
the City Recorder by publication
of a full copy of this ordinance in
the City of Medford, Oregon,
Tribune, a newspaper published
and of general circulation within
the City of Medford, Oregon, two
of which publications shall be not
less than ten days prior to said
election, and by causing a full copy
of this ordinance to be posted in
a public place at or near each of
the polling places specified, and
at three other public
places within the City of Medford,
Oregon, not less than two weeks prior
to said election.

SECTION 6. That there shall be
submitted to the legal voters of the
City of Medford at said special
election the following proposed act
of municipal legislation amending
the Charter of the City of Medford,
Oregon, as amended, to be known
as Ordinance No. 7190, to-wit:
OFF-STREET PARKING
FEES TO BE PAID BY THE PEOPLE BY
THE CITY COUNCIL

To amend the City Charter of the
City of Medford, Oregon, by adding
therein a section 22-2-2 authorizing
the said City to pledge to the pay-
ment of off-street parking facilities
in accordance with the provisions of
ORS 223-849 to 223-879, in addition
to other revenues and assessments
authorized by the City Charter, and
the full faith and credit of said city,
and providing for additional means
of acquiring property for such
purpose:

County a certified list of the quali-
fied electors of the City of Medford,
and to prepare poll books
