Teleprinter Rate Hike Effective On Private Lines

Washington -UPI- Temporary teleprinter rate increases on Western Union Telegraph Co. and American Telephone & Telegraph Co. private lines went into effect Tuesday. The increases are designed to yield the companies \$15 million more in revenues a year.

The Federal Communications Commission allowed the teleprinter service hikes to go into effect despite heavy protests from major users of the service.

Appeal Rejected

The commission Monday rejected an 11th hour appeal by the New York Central Railroad to hold up the increases for three months to give the commission time to reach a decision in its long-range study of "reasonable" charges for such services.

United Press International, the American Newspaper Publishers Association, the National Association of Broadcasters, the American Stock Exchange, Telegrapher, three Trans-Lux news companies, the Chesapeake and Ohio Railway and the federal government's General Services Administration were among major users who strongly protested the boost.

By order of the FCC both Western Union and AT&T must keep accurate accounts of their increased charges in case the interim hikes are later found to be too high and refunds are ordered.

Western Union's rate hikes are expected to yield it \$5 million in new income annually and the AT&T hikes will bring in \$8,400,000 a year more to that firm.

Would Curtail Service

UPI contended the increases, if allowed to take effect, would force small newspapers and radio stations to curtail or get rid of their news agency services, thus re-

Modern Electric Ranges Cut Cooking Time to Little Work

Do you know which household job women like best?

Survey after survey indicates that women get the most enjoyment out of cooking. The reason is simple: cooking is creative work.

You'll never be able to settle the argument as to whether she is a better cook than grandmother was. But one thing is certain. With today's modern electric ranges the modern housewife can do things Grandma would never have thought of trying - and all with a minimum of work.

Fancy Dishes

That's even more true this Christmas than it was as recently as two or three years ago. Thermostatic controls have now been successfully applied to surface cooking units as well as the oven. The housewife who owns a modern electric range with these automatic controls can put the pan on the surface cooker, twist a dial and walk out of the kitchen.

A "sensing" element feels the temperature of the sauce-

pan and relays this to an automatic control which keeps heat at full intensity, lowers it slightly, brings it back up - cuts it off almost completely - keeping the dish always at the temperature the housewife selected on the control dial.

Cooking Simplified

Even the more familiar cooking operations have been simplified by today's range. Take broiling, for example. You've always been able to broil but often it was a messy job. That's no longer the case, thanks to modern spatter-proof broilers. And the roasteries and "elevator" broilers in today's ranges make possible a variety of broiling techniques unheard of in Grandma's kitchen.

Best of all, there's little

"hangover" to cooking with a modern electric range. The units have been designed for easy cleaning. Some ovens have doors which can be lifted off and others have "drop leaf" doors to facilitate cleaning.

Surface units swing up and away from the drip pans for easy cleaning. Actually, the automatic control features incorporated in a modern range do much to simplify clean-up afterward by eliminating many spills, boil-overs and burning dishes.

So, for the job she likes best, help your wife be her creative best by giving her the best tools available. In cooking, that means a modern electric range.

The Family Council

Editor's note: The Family Council consists of a judge, a psychiatrist, three clergymen, a newspaper editor, a women's editor and two writers. Each article is a summary of an actual report. The Family Council does not give advice; it merely reports on problems that have been dealt with by responsible agencies and counselors.

Mrs. L. T. - My husband and I are terribly worried about our 20-year-old daughter who dates men out of our faith.

We aren't prejudiced or narrow-minded and we think there are good and bad individuals in all churches but we don't think mixed marriages are good. There are so many problems in marriage, why look for trouble?

We have tried to get Elaine to come to the various social activities connected with our church, but she either refuses or she goes and then complains for weeks afterward about the awful time she had and how much she disliked all the young men at the gathering. She criticizes them so much that there is nothing left of them by the time she gets through. But I don't see where the ones she goes out with are so superior.

Elaine T. - I am not religious and it means nothing at all to me to marry within the faith my parents claim I belong to. How, by the way, can you belong to faith you don't believe in?

Anyway, as it happens, I have not yet married any of the men I've been dating and there is nobody in sight about whom I feel serious. I can't see any harm in dating outside your religion. Dating is not the same as marriage.

My parents just don't understand that I can't relax and enjoy myself if I am forced to go out with one of the jerks they recommend. Somehow the ones they want me to go out with are always the worst specimens. They don't treat me nearly as nicely as the boys I have dated out of my own choice. I can't date to please my parents.

The Council: Elaine's excuse that she is merely dating, not marrying, doesn't hold up.

She is perfectly aware that dating is a preliminary to marriage - an essential preliminary in a society where marriages are not arranged by families.

We think that Elaine is being dishonest with her parents and, more important, herself, on other scores as well. Her wholesale rejection of the young men of her own faith is not a rational act. It is an unreasonable prejudice against her own kind.

In addition to devotion to God according to certain precepts, religious faith represents a family tradition that has been handed down through the ages. Certain traditions may change with the generations, but total rejection of the faith of our fathers involves a rejection of a good part of ourselves.

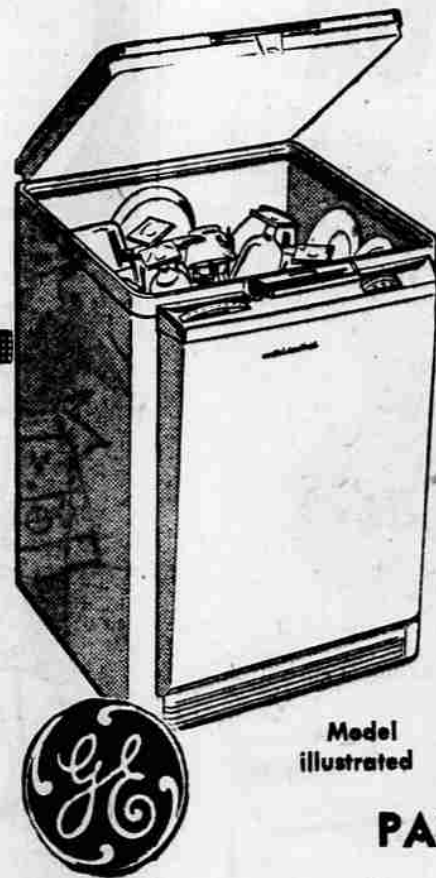
We'll make allowances for true religious conversion and for the fact that love and friendship dissolves barriers, but the fact remains that those who consistently go out of their way to find friends and marriage partners outside their own faith, have a compulsion to destroy part of their own personality. As long as this destructive need exists, the possibilities are not in favor of a successful marriage.

Family pressure probably won't make much of a dent in Elaine's attitudes, but we urge her to try to be a little more self-critical and to try to find the real facts behind her unreasonable prejudice against her own kind. We would also suggest that she expose herself to a greater understanding of the precepts of her own faith.

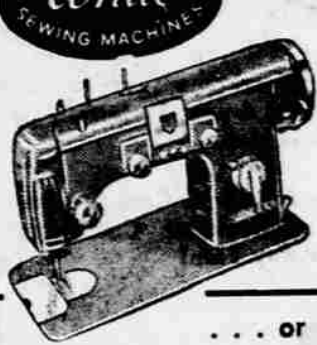
