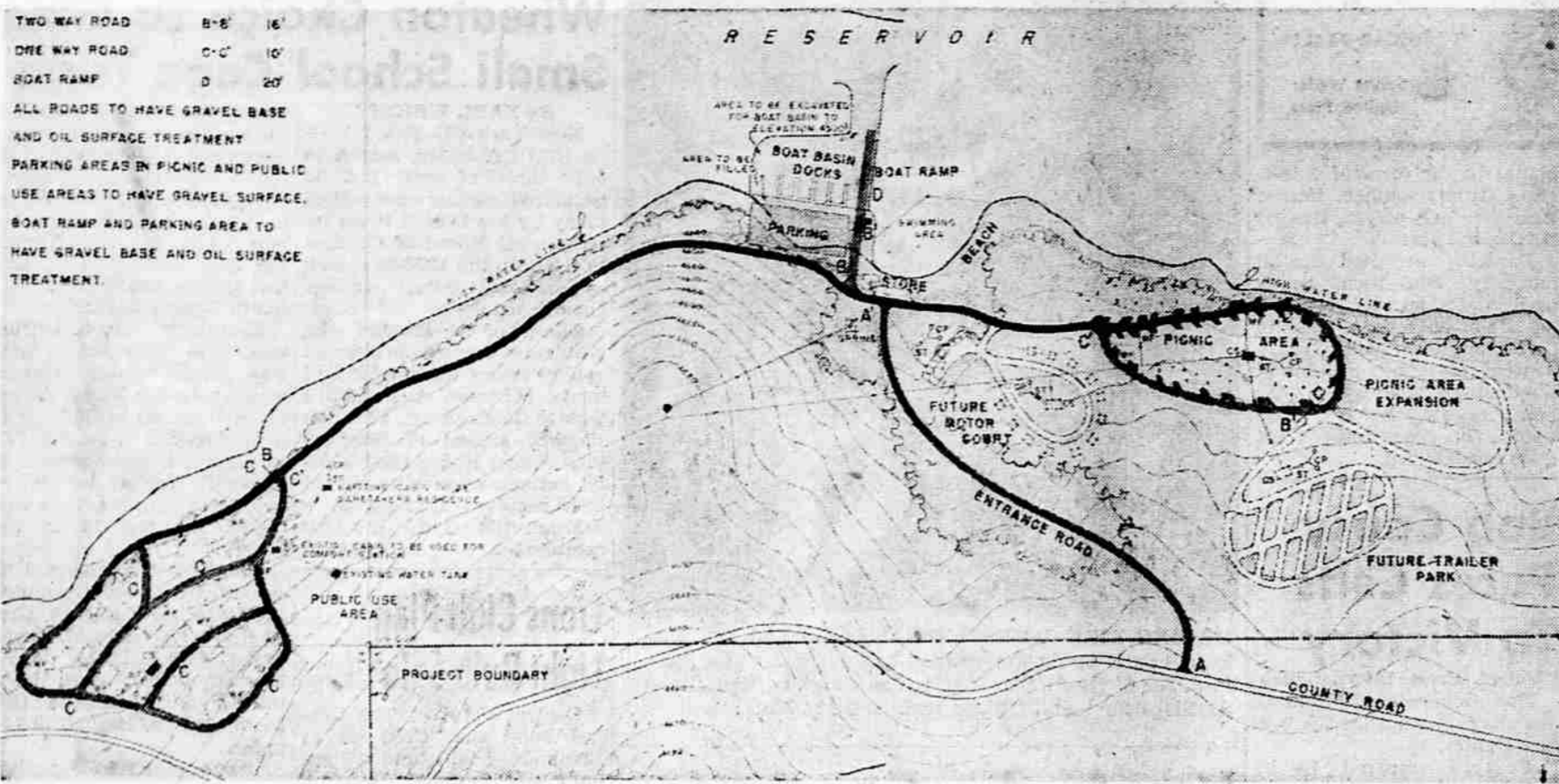

Morse Suggests Neuberger's Cancer Cause for Souring of Friendship

Washington—(UP)—Sen. Wayne Morse suggested on Wednesday night that the cancer suffered by his colleague, Sen. Richard L. Neuberger, accounts—at least in part—for the souring of their close personal friendship.

"It is my judgment that his illness explains psychologically, even more than he may know, his conduct towards me," Morse said in a statement commenting on a nation's news magazine's report on the bitter feud between the two Oregon Democrats.

Morse said he was happy to hear that Neuberger is "well on his way to full recovery" from an operation for removal of a malignant growth. Neuberger has announced the illness and has curtailed his activity during his convalescence.

request and Morse opposing it. At one point during the debate, Morse called a Neuberger argument the "most absurd," he ever had heard in the Senate.

The feud reached a climax in the final days of the session when Morse blocked the Senate passage of a Neuberger bill involving the city of Roseburg, Ore. The sharp exchange of letters followed.

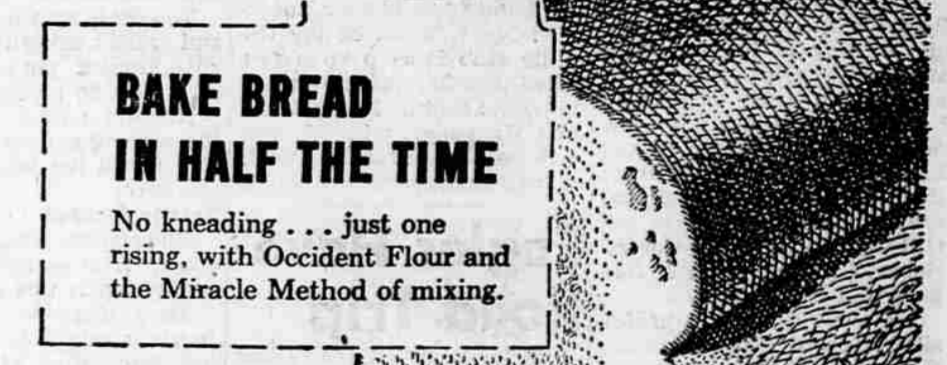
