

Elks Club Gives Salvation Army \$1,000 for Fund

The Medford Elks club has turned over to the Salvation Army here \$1,000 for the Army's Christmas and Winter Relief fund, according to Capt. William Ricken.

Last year, the fund provided 168 baskets of groceries to families in need in Medford and Jackson county. More than 700 persons were in the families and 38 transient men received a turkey dinner at the Salvation Army shelter, he said.

The fund also provided 417 children with 1,225 toys and candy the annual Christmas party sponsored by the Salvation Army for children. A total of 1,500 people were visited and presented gifts in the county jail, county farm home, Camp White and rest homes.

Kettles Downtown
The Salvation Army's kettles have been in the downtown area since late last month, and the response has been about the same as last year at this time, Captain Ricken reported. He said the Army hopes to raise about \$6,000 in order to meet the SA's needs.

All Christmas basket requests are cleared through the Inter-Agency Christmas bureau to avoid duplication of giving with other organizations.

Captain Ricken said about 25 families have applied for assistance, and are being checked to determine the extent of need.

The Medford Elks club assists the Salvation Army by helping to pack and deliver Christmas baskets.

Regulus Missile Flight Declared Highly Successful

Point Mugu, Calif. — (UPI) — The Navy today labelled as highly successful a 400-mile flight of its mighty Regulus II guided missile capable of carrying an atomic warhead.

The potent Regulus II Wednesday spanned the width of California and successfully landed at an isolated desert area near Tonopah, Nev.

Launched From Ship
The supersonic missile designed for operational use from atomic-powered submarines was launched for the first time from a deck of a surface ship, the LST King County, off the California coast.

Flight of the missile, which differs from a ballistic missile in that it can be controlled during flight while a ballistic missile is largely beyond directional control after launching, lasted for nearly an hour.

The 11-ton 57-foot Regulus II was launched in a blinding cloud of smoke and sent first out to sea for 15 minutes for a final safety test before a controlling airplane sent it hurtling back towards land and its destination in Nevada.

Control Shifts
Control of the missile shifted several times during the long flight—with Point Mugu Station, Edwards Air Force Base and two jet planes at various times controlling its course.

The missile, capable of speeds up to 1,500 miles an hour and of an altitude of 60,000 feet, was slowed down by a specially-designed parachute after it landed on a portable landing gear.

The Regulus II had been successfully fired four times before — once from a submarine and three times from launching pads on the ground.

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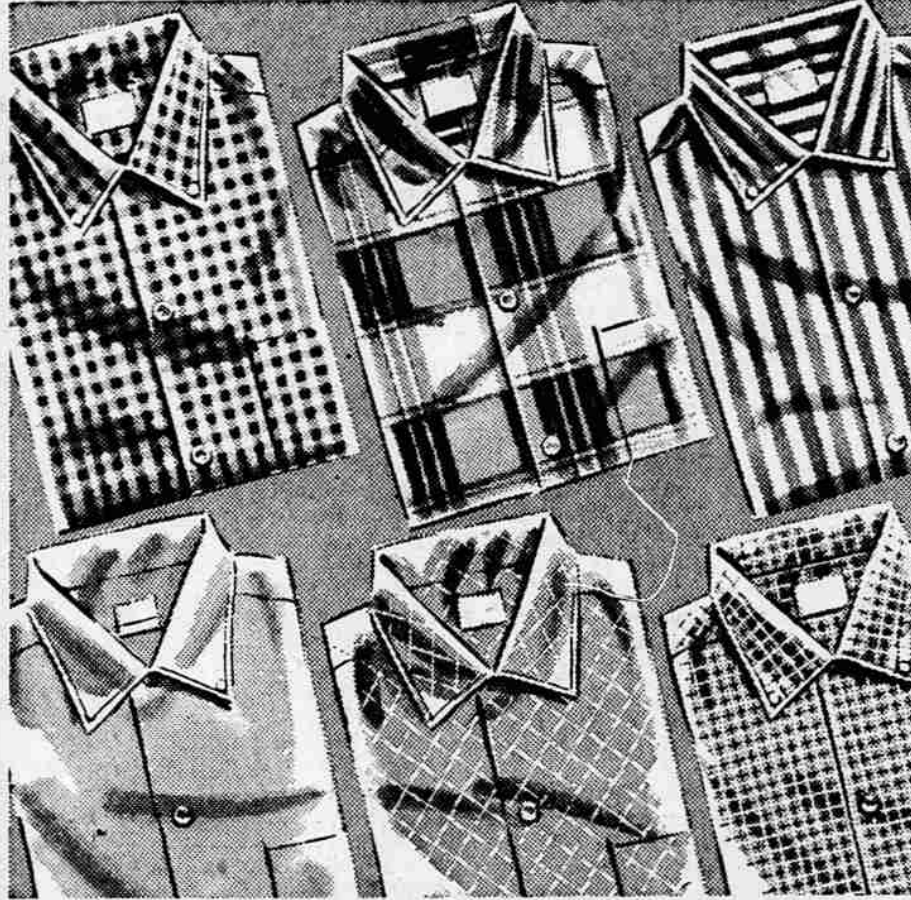

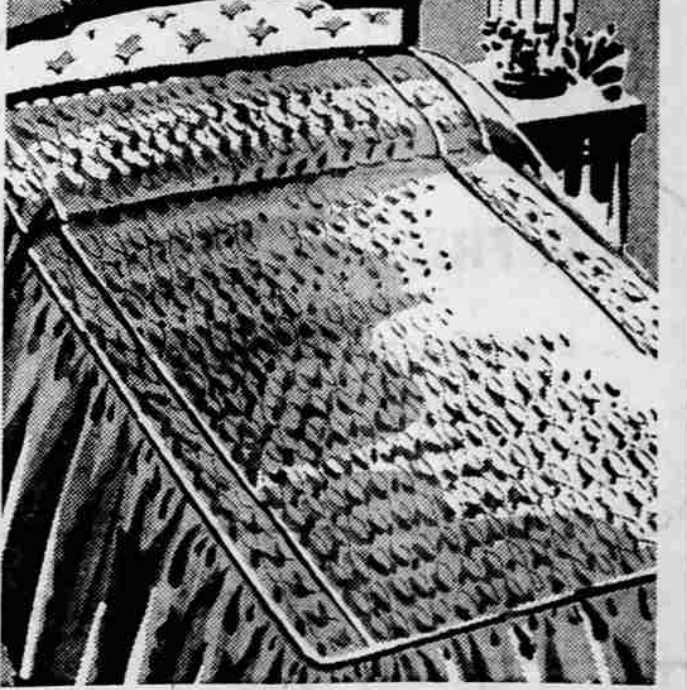
