Winter Potato Yield Estimated

Washington—UPI—The Agriculture Department Wednesday forecast 1959 production of winter potatoes at 4,170,000 hundred weight, 16 per cent below last year but 2 per cent above average.

In California the acreage for harvest was placed at 14,300 acres 32 per cent below the 1958 acreage.

Florida acreage was estimated at 12,700 acres or 6 per cent below the 1958 harvested acreage. The department said growers of early spring potatoes in Florida and Texas reported intentions to plant 26,500 acres for the 1959 crop, 19 per cent below the 1958 acreage. Most of the early spring crop is grown in Florida.

Unemployment Said Levelled Off

Washington—UPI—Unemployment leveled off last month instead of showing its usual sharp November increase, the government has reported.

Census Bureau figures showed that joblessness throughout the country rose 28,000 to a total of 3,833,000 last month. This change is within the range of statistical error in compiling the figures, however, and is not regarded as significant.

Last year, when the recession was picking up momentum, unemployment climbed from 2,508,000 from October to November.

The Labor and Commerce departments reported that employment fell by 653,000 to 64,653,000 last month because of seasonal curtailment of farm activities.

Planes Assigned To Far East Returning

Honolulu—UPI—Powerful American air units, rushed to the Far East during the Formosa crisis last summer, are returning to their bases in the United States.

A group of B57 Canberra jet bombers arrived at Hickam Air Force Base Tuesday. An Air Force spokesman said they were part of a flight of 14 due back from the Far East. They were scheduled to take off from Southern California sometime today.

During the past few days, at least 15 KB 50 jet tankers and 10 C130 transports have also arrived here, presumably from Formosa.

Monday night, the 83rd Fighter-Interceptor Squadron, equipped with ultrasonic F104 Starfighters, began returning home to Hamilton Air Force Base, Calif., after more than three months at the Chinese Nationalist stronghold.
