Teamsters Plan Member Drive During Winter

Miami Beach —UPD— Teamsters boss Jimmy Hoffa will meet with his lieutenants this winter to lay plans for a huge organizing campaign which they hope will bring 10 million state, county, and municipal government employees—including police—into the giant union.

Hoffa, who announced the move Wednesday, said Teamsters groups probably will meet in Washington in January or February to plan the nationwide drive. He said money is available and will be spent, but declined to give a figure.

Not To Be Raid
The drive, to be aimed at hospital workers, policemen, firemen, sanitation men and others, will not be a raid on any established union, Hoffa said, but will attempt to bring in all unorganized groups.

Hoffa said he realized that such employees as policemen should be in a different classification regarding strikes.

In line with this, a New York Teamster official said the union will open a "guinea pig" case next week in a drive to organize the city's police department.

Harry Feinstein, president of Teamsters Local 237 of New York City, said the test case would begin next week in an attempt to force the police department to check off union dues.

State Farm Prices Set Slight Gain, Retail Prices Up

Corvallis—Prices received by Oregon farmers for their products averaged slightly higher last month, in contrast to national farm prices which slipped a cog, reported Mrs. Elvera Horrell, extension agricultural economist at Oregon State college.

Higher prices received by the state's farmers for their eggs and broilers, milk and milk cows, potatoes, apples, hay, and some grains more than offset lower prices on turkeys, butterfat, meat animals, and some seeds, Mrs. Horrell said. As a result, the combined average price of all farm products in Oregon rose 2 per cent last month to a level 4 per cent above a year ago.

At the same time, national farm prices lost ground, pulled lower by oranges, hogs, cotton, corn, and tobacco, Mrs. Horrell found as she studied reports from the U. S. department of agriculture. Higher national prices on fresh market vegetables, potatoes, apples, and milk cushioned the decline some, but not enough to prevent the slight sag.

Retail Prices Move Up
While prices received by farmers over the nation were moving down, prices of things they pay moved up a shade to another new all-time high, Mrs. Horrell also found.

As a result, the parity ratio dropped one point during November and now stands at 81, Mrs. Horrell said. This is the same ratio between prices farmers receive and prices they pay for goods and services as a year earlier, but still 19 points below the level set by Congress as a "fair" exchange rate, she pointed out.

Prices paid by farmers for living items also came in for gains last month, Mrs. Horrell reported. Higher price tags on new cars had a big hand in pushing family living items higher, but clothing, food, and building materials also moved up some. Prices of living items hit a new November high, and are now only a third of one per cent below the all-time peak of last May.

Liquor Outlet Hours Unchanged

Portland —UPD— The Oregon Liquor Control Commission said today it has decided to leave the hours of operation for liquor outlets unchanged.

Administrator George Van Bergen said the matter came up because some persons had suggested "equalizing" hours for taverns, clubs and other outlets. Taverns at present may remain open until 1 a.m. and restaurants, clubs and lounges until 2:30 a.m. Van Bergen said a hearing held Tuesday produced no real reason for a change.

The OLCC accepted the retirement resignation of L. B. Russell, license supervisor, and appointed John E. Martin, manager of the Portland office of the Civil Service Commission, to succeed him.
