

Ragsdale Presides At Banquet During Recent Convention

Lee Ragsdale, supervisor of health, physical education and safety for Medford public schools, presided at a convention banquet of the Oregon Association for Health, Physical Education and Recreation recently in Bend. Ragsdale was president of the association last year.

Elsa Schneider, specialist in health, physical education and recreation with the U.S. office of education, was principal speaker at the banquet.

Miss Schneider, who recently returned from observing school programs in Europe and Russia, compared the American educational system with ones she observed abroad.

Should Examine System

"People who are advocating that we copy the educational system in Russia should examine such a system first hand," she said. Miss Schneider said that many successful professional people in this country would have been channeled into a trade school when 10 years old under the Russian system.

Awards for distinguished programs in health and physical education were presented to the Bethel school district. Medford received the health award in 1957-58, Ragsdale noted.

Dr. H. Harrison Clarke, of the University of Oregon, reported to the research section of recent findings of the Medford growth study.

In addition to Ragsdale, others from Medford at the convention were Pat Mounts, Janice Crisp and Loren Soderlund. Ashland people attending included Beverly Bennett, Ruth Beber and Dr. Alex Peterson, all of Southern Oregon college, and Warren La Bounty of Ashland public schools.

Peterson completed his term as vice president for research and La Bounty was elected vice president for supervision and administration.
