The appointment of the one-time University of Arkansas star was announced by Forty Niner President Victor P. Morabito.

Upsets Featured In Lively Fisticuffs

United Press International—Upsets featured the year's liveliest boxing night Monday, although a world champion and a European titleholder won their bouts handily.

Paul Pender—in his second bout after three years absence from the ring—stopped Pete Adams of Newark, N. J. in the fourth round.

However, Pascual Perez of Argentina made a successful eighth defense of the world flyweight title by winning a unanimous 15-round decision over Filipino Donny Ursea before 40,000 at Manila—largest crowd in Philippine fight history.

And at Paris, Gustav Scholz of Germany, European middleweight champion, outpointed mustachioed Germain Ballarin of France in a 10-round non-title bout.
