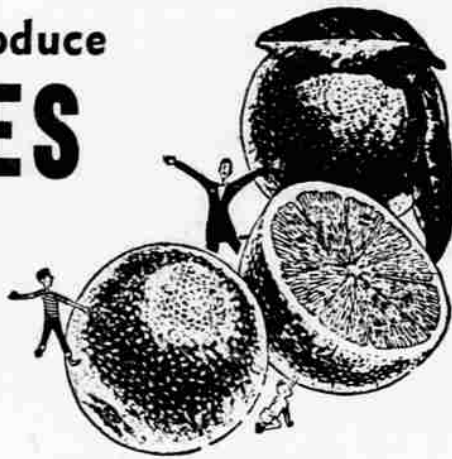

Telephone Stockholders Share in Split

New York (UPI)—Stockholders of the American Telephone and Telegraph Corp. today shared in a one and a half billion dollar Christmas pie—the product of a 21-point rise in the company's stock.

The increase, which boosted AT&T stock to \$225 a share, occurred Wednesday after the company announced plans to split its stock three-for-one and raise its dividends. The stock finally closed Wednesday at \$223 a share.

AT&T, which serves approximately 85 per cent of the nation's 86 million telephones, is the world's largest investor-owned company, with total assets of more than \$17 billion. In all, more than 1,600,000 Americans from every walk of life own AT&T stock, a stockholder family bigger than the next three companies combined.

Caught Off Base
The stock split and dividend rise, although long rumored, caught Wall Street off base. The ensuing rush for AT&T stock forced suspension of trading for an hour and a half, while specialists sought stock to supply the demand.

AT&T, whose stock has been a "blue chip" investment for many years, has maintained a \$9 annual dividend rate since 1921. Company directors said that if the stockholders approve the split at their annual meeting April 15, they will recommend an annual dividend rate on the new stock of \$3.30 a share. This would be equivalent to \$9.90 on the present stock.
