

Navy Successfully Tests Bathyscaph

San Diego, Calif. (AP)—The Navy has conducted the first manned submergence of its 125-ton bathyscaph Trieste—the Navy's latest underwater research tool which could lead to the development of new vessels for traveling under the oceans.

Spokesmen at the Navy electronics laboratory said the test was "a complete success." The craft with a two-man crew stayed submerged in 70 feet of water off the Pacific Coast for 13 minutes Wednesday.

The Trieste operates on the same theory as the lighter-than-air blimp, only in reverse. It uses 28,000 gallons of gasoline (which is lighter than water) to gain its buoyancy and metal ballast to cause it to descend.

Jacque Piccard, European designer of the craft, said it is capable of taking man to great depths in the seas.
