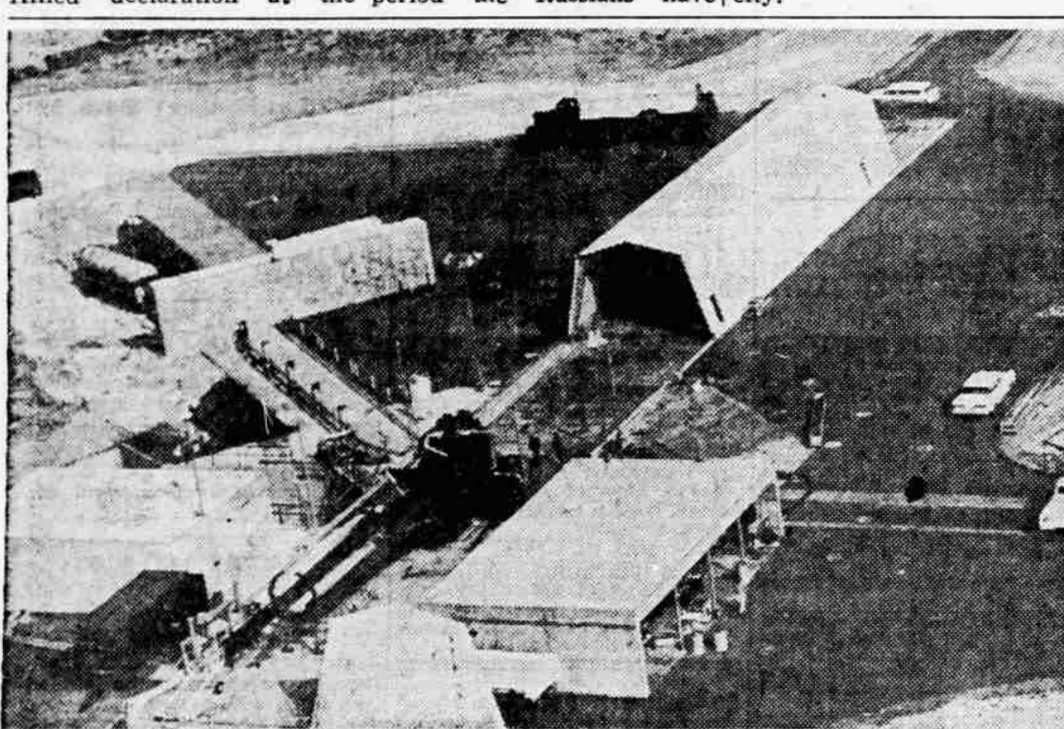

West Berliners Want Ultimatum

Berlin—UPI—Worried West Berliners Wednesday sought a stronger declaration from the West on the future of the city—an Allied ultimatum that further Soviet moves would mean war.

They were pleased with the Allied declaration at the NATO Council that Soviet Russia would not risk a nuclear war over Berlin but they wanted something stronger.

Sentiment favoring such a Western ultimatum built up as the first three weeks passed of the six months waiting given the West to quit the city.
