Neuberger Urges Federal Aid for Medical Students

Portland—UPI—Sen. Richard L. Neuberger (D-Ore.) said Thursday that medical students should be allowed to share in direct benefits of the federal scholarship bill.
Neuberger told a meeting of the American Veterans committee here that costs of medical education "are so staggering today that many of our most able and talented young men and women are discouraged from ever becoming physicians."

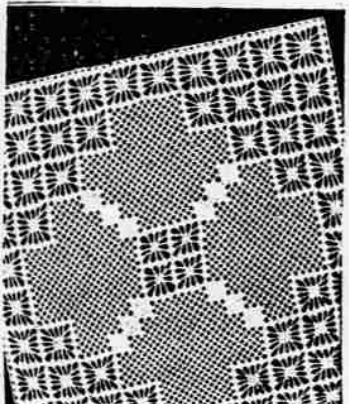
He said a four-year course required up to \$10,000 or more and added "financial rewards during the beginning period of internship are virtually negligible."
Proposes Amendment

The Oregon lawmaker proposed an amendment to the federal scholarship act which would permit medical students to borrow up to \$3500 at low rates of interest. He proposed that 50 per cent of the loan be "forgiven by the government if the new doctor then will spend at least five consecutive years in medical research, where lies the hope of the future in fighting such diseases as cancer, heart ailments and mental illness."

He said the proposal was parallel to federal existing loan rebates to undergraduates who are willing to spend their first five years as school teachers after receiving their college degrees.
