



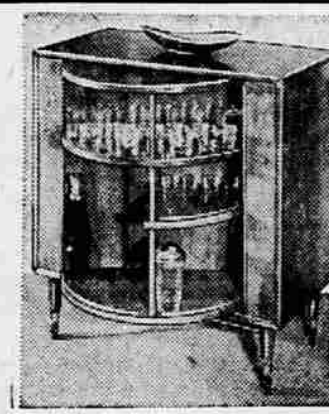

Contrary to the popular impression, he said, the bikini is regaining favor in the United States, Germany, and France, because of the increase in private swimming pools where modesty is no object. Jantzen previewed new bathing suit styles in an international fashion show recently held in the hangar of the new Pan American 707 jet commercial airliner in New York. The Oriental influence in the line was strong. It showed in fabrics, colors, and silhouettes. The leotard, popular this past year, was replaced by Hellanca suits with short sleeves.
