

Show People Give Doctor Busy Sunday

Santa Monica, Calif. — (UPI)—Dr. A. C. Meitus had a busy day Sunday—first he attended Dennis Crosby's wife while she gave birth to a son.

A short time later Dr. Meitus was called back to the hospital where he officiated at the birth of a son to actress Jayne Mansfield.

Dr. Meitus said the two mothers and their babies were doing well at St. John's hospital.

"It's a boy," Mickey Hargitay, a former Mr. Universe, shouted as he emerged from Miss Mansfield's bedside at the hospital. "Now we've everything we ever wanted."

Hargitay said the 9½-pound baby was named Miklos after him. He had taken his blonde wife to the hospital about nine hours before the birth. The baby was due to be born on Dec. 9, he said.

Rough on Nerves
"That is rough on nerves," waiting like that, the jubilant musician said. "I was positive it would be a boy but still it was a surprise."

Miss Mansfield said from her hospital bed: "I feel wonderful. He's a dream of a baby."

She has a daughter, Jayne Marie, 8, from a previous marriage.

Pat Sheehan, 26, former Las Vegas showgirl, gave birth to an 8-pound, 14-ounce boy. He was named Dennis Michael Crosby Jr.

Dr. Meitus said both Mrs. Crosby and Miss Mansfield and their babies probably would be able to go home in time for Christmas.

Apathy Toward Communism Told

Washington — (UPI) — FBI Director J. Edgar Hoover has said that public apathy toward the threat of Communist subversion continued to grow in 1958.

Such apathy, he said, encouraged "dupes and sympathizers" of the Communist Party to attack the nation's law enforcement agencies during the past year.

The FBI chief made his observations in a year-end report to Atty. Gen. William P. Rogers. The report was made public Sunday night.

"Sensing a more favorable atmosphere," Hoover said, "the Communist Party, U.S.A., and its dupes and sympathizers gained further courage and became more vocal in their attacks upon law enforcement and other professions which are dedicated to preserving our freedoms."

In his report to Rogers, Hoover said that formulating positive programs to infiltrate mass organizations and establishment of a new Communist youth group were among the party's "most ambitious" activities during 1958.

Hoover also said 1958 was marked by an increase in crime, especially against banking institutions.

Suspects Arrested In Eugene Robbery

Eugene — (UPI) — Two suspects were arrested Sunday night four minutes after a service station was robbed of \$283 here.

Police said a man who palmed what appeared to be a gun took the money from attendant James Hill, 23, as Hill was closing up a station at 10:30 p.m. Hill telephoned a description of the car. At 10:30 p.m. officer Tom Enright stopped a car and arrested two men identified by Police as Sylvester Guy Earl, 26, Eugene, and Howard J. Woods, 30, Springfield. Police said the money was recovered.

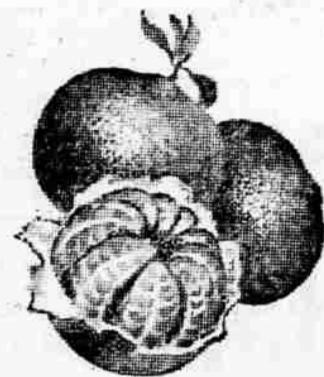

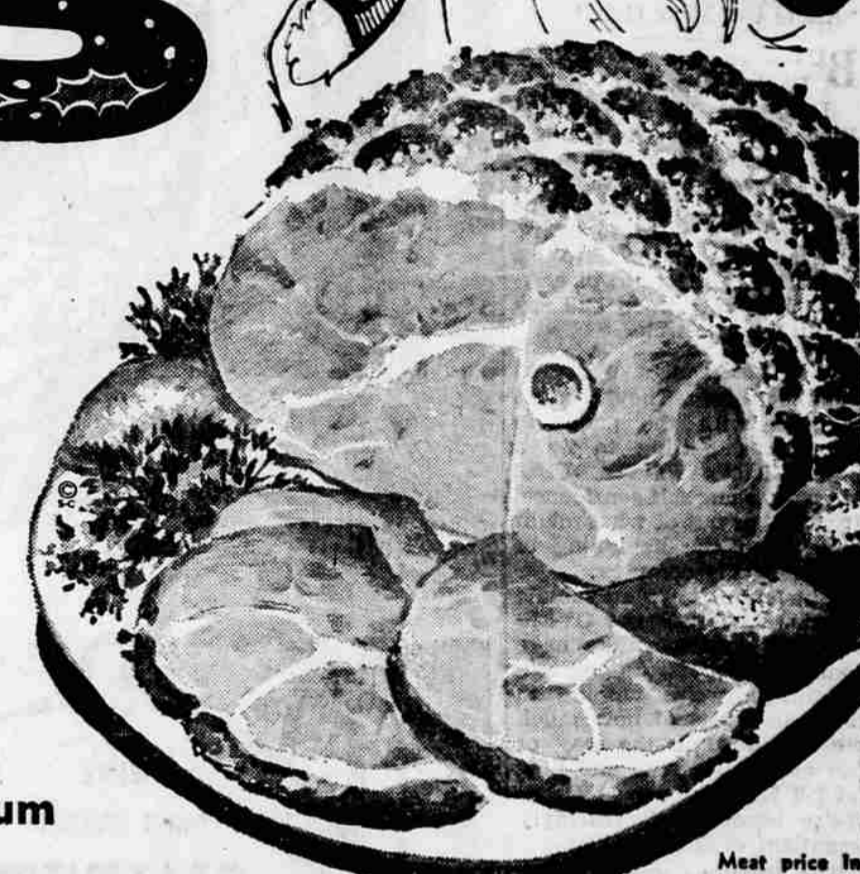

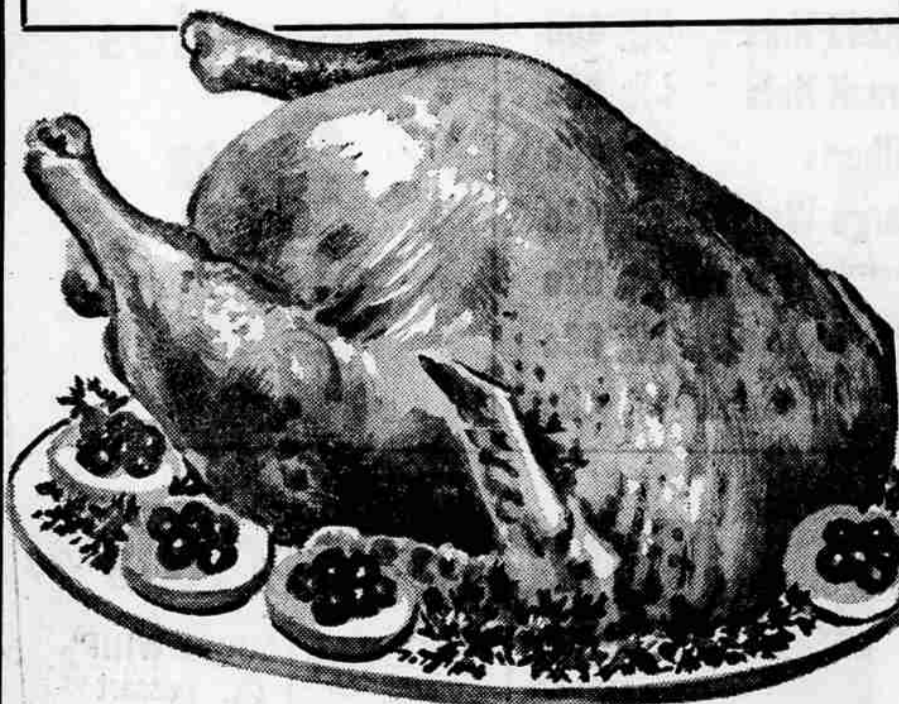
