

Traffic Volume Shows Increase

Traffic volume in southern Oregon showed considerable increase in November compared with a year ago, according to counts made at four check points by the state highway department.

A 13.3 per cent increase over November, 1957, was noted on Highway 99 two miles south of Talent, where an average daily count of 7,538 vehicles was tabulated by the automatic traffic recorder.

An average daily total of 1,571 was recorded at Shady Cove on Highway 62, for an increase of 18.4 per cent over the previous year. Oregon Highway 238 at Ruch accounted for an average daily total of 473 vehicles, an increase of 7.3 per cent.

Highway 66 in the Siskiyou near Ashland totaled 1,092 daily for a 14.1 per cent increase.

Oregon highway traffic on the whole increased 4.2 per cent in November, compared with a year ago.

HODGKIN'S DISEASE

Every so often, in order to answer a lot of questions, I write a column on Hodgkin's disease. Usually what happens is that a frantic mother writes saying that her only son has been told he has Hodgkin's disease and has been sent to an x-ray man for treatment. The mother asked her doctor what Hodgkin's disease is, and he said he didn't have time to write her a lecture on the subject. When she got to the x-ray man, she begged him to tell her, but he said that wasn't his business. He advised her to go back and get the information from her doctor. Then she asked the doctor's nurse, and she said "If I told you, you wouldn't understand it." Then she went to the library and looked it up, and read that it is sort of half lymph condition between an infection and a cancerous tumor, and that the outlook is not too hopeful.

Actually, there is much evidence today to indicate—but not prove—that the disease is due to a virus. Whatever it is, it acts like an infection which causes great enlargement of the lymph nodes in many parts of the body. A man of 30 or so will suddenly discover that the glands on the sides of his neck are as big as wal-

Eugene—Total bank debits in November for southwest Oregon were 10.4 per cent above November last year and 2.3 per cent below October 1958, according to the bureau of business research in the University of Oregon.

The bureau collects reports of bank debits from throughout the state. Debits are considered indicators of business activity.

The debit total for 11 banks in Curry, Jackson and Josephine counties this November was \$78,856,984. State total was 167 reporting banks was \$1,806,370,812, 7.0 per cent below October, and 5.8 per cent above November last year.
