

### Balloon Believed Down in Middle of Atlantic Ocean

New York—UPI—The missing balloon Small World that left the Canary Islands Dec. 12 on a transatlantic aerial voyage today was believed to be down in the middle of the Atlantic Ocean.

The balloon, with a specially designed gondola that could be converted into a sailboat if forced down, was manned by a crew of three men and one woman on its attempted free flight across the Atlantic.

Peter Elstob, promoter of the aerial voyage, said he believed the balloon was forced to land in the Atlantic during a heavy rainstorm.

**No Fear Felt**  
"Judging by the balloon's speed up until the time of last radio contact on Dec. 18, I would estimate that it went down just about in the middle of the Atlantic Ocean," Elstob told United Press International today.

Elstob said he felt certain the crew would complete the crossing under sail.

"The special gondola was designed by Colin Mudie, one of the crewmen, who is both a naval architect and an experienced seaman," Elstob said.

"According to the plan, Bushy Elloart was to be in command of the operation while the balloon was airborne. In the event of a forced landing at sea, Mudie was to take command because of his vast experience in sailing. He also is the navigator.

**Three Weeks Expected**  
Elstob said he believed it would take the gondola about three weeks to sail the remaining 1,500 miles to the West Indies.

The tiny vessel carried 20 gallons of fresh water but was equipped with four solar stills for converting sea water to fresh water. It also carried a two-months supply of food for the crew.

The crew, in addition to Elloart, 51, and Mudie, 32, including Mudie's wife, Rosemary, 30, and Elloart's son, Timothy, 21, the radio operator.

Elstob said that earlier reports from Venezuela that the Small World had landed there apparently were a hoax.

### Civil Rights Proposals Ready For New Congress

Washington—UPI—The Justice Department today prepared a highly secret package of civil rights legislative proposals to be presented to the new Congress.

Attorney General William P. Rogers has been holding almost daily conferences at the department to work out the form of the Administration proposals. He also has made a number of trips to the White House.

**Lid on Discussions**  
But the attorney general has clamped a lid on any discussions of the details. Department officials said they did not want a premature announcement because some measures are not yet crystallized.

The wraps will be taken off the program by President Eisenhower in his State of the Union message to Congress, officials said.

They said "anything that is proposed will be with the serious intention of having it passed by Congress." Some persons outside the Administration have said they do not expect the department to make any startling new proposals.

The administration officials said they were trying to avoid legislation which might have a popular appeal such as drastic anti-bomb laws, but which would not "legally hold water."

**New Subpoena Powers**  
Administration officials have said they would seek new subpoena powers for the Justice Department. Such powers, similar to those held by the Internal Revenue Service, would give the department easier access to records, including voting registration rolls.

In addition the Administration is expected to recommend that Congress prolong the life of the Civil Rights Commission beyond the September, 1959, deadline.

**Columbia River Smelt On Portland Market**  
Portland—UPI—The season's first Columbia river smelt arrived on the market here today. About 50 pounds, caught by Clatskanie district fishermen, were expected to retail around 75 cents a pound.
