Poison-Proofing Your Home

I recently received a copy of an excellent brochure which should be in every home where there are children. It tells where the common poisons are that kill children, and how people should take poisons that come into our homes. The folder can be obtained free from "Poison Proofing Your Home," 130 East 59th St., Room 800, New York 22, N.Y.

Every so often the mother ought to check through the house to make sure that no poison has been left lying around. Often a medicine is left on the night table beside an adult's bed, and there a small child gets it. Watch out for detergents; they are not good for children's stomachs. It may help to start training children early to know that certain things are poisonous and must never be touched.

The company specifically sought permission to spend an estimated \$129,500,000 for a 614-mile pipeline from the Idaho-British Columbia inter-sectional boundary near Kingsgate, B. C., to the Oregon-California border south-east of Klamath Falls, Ore.

life. With some poisons the giving of egg white mixed with milk will help. If the child vomits, it is good to save the vomitus because this can be analyzed later. Often the mother can take the handle of a spoon and with it tickle the back of the child's throat until he vomits.

In cases of vitiligo, there are patches of skin which turn white. This distresses many of the patients a great deal, especially when the patches are on the face or the neck or the hands. There have been reports of some good results from the taking of certain drugs, but my friends who are skin specialists do not seem to be enthusiastic about this type of treatment, and I have reports of cases in which the drug did harm.

My feeling is, that for the present, the best thing a person can do is to get some of Lydia E. Pinkham's "Covermark" and with this to cover the white area so that it looks like normal skin.
