Design for Flag Still Top Secret

Washington -UPI- The design for the 49-star United States flag, with Alaska represented, was still a top-secret today.

But the best educated guess was that the nation's new banner, which will go into general use July 4, will look pretty much like the present Old Glory.

Some flag manufacturers and well-informed congressional and government sources said it's a good bet that the stars will be arranged seven across and seven down.

President Eisenhower, who appointed a special commission to redesign the flag, will announce the historic decision at noon Saturday when he signs a proclamation bringing Alaska into the union as the 49th state.

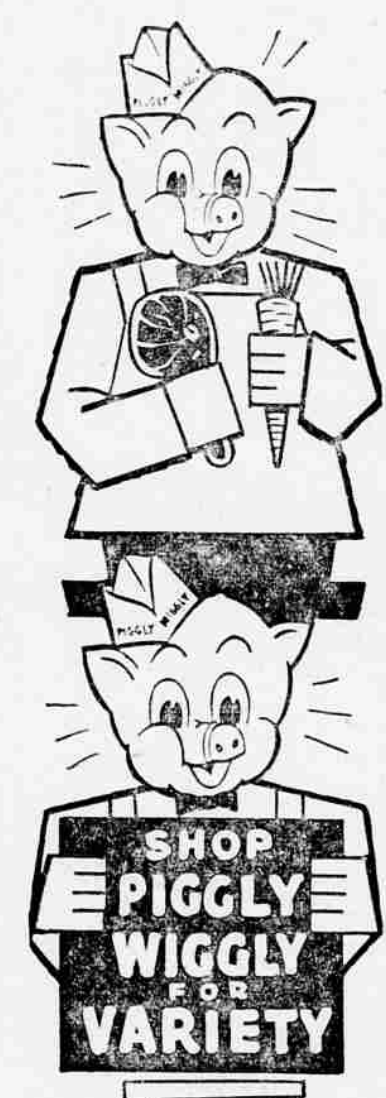
