

Is That So?

Ermine is the fur of royalty, and it comes from a weasel in a winter coat with the added distinction of having a tail tip that is always black.

In other words, if you caught sight of a weasel in his brownish summer coat, you'd have to look mighty

fast to tell whether he was one of the ermine type. And since most weasels, ermine bearing or not, don't change to their white winter fur until after snowfall, that brings up the interesting point of how and why the weasel makes the change only then.

One explanation is that the shortening days of the year result in less light for the animal's eyes, thus slowing the work of the pituitary gland and reducing the pigmentation in the hair.

Maybe so, but occasionally even in the most northern parts of the country, snow doesn't come until January—sometimes in a severe winter. The shortest day of the year, however, is about Dec. 21. Since the summer solstice is

June, the days have been getting shorter. From Dec. 21 on they lengthen again, and presumably the weasel's pituitary gland picks up, supplying more pigmentation to his coat.

Presumably also, if the increasing light loss to the weasel's eyes due to the shortening day causes the coat change, then the change would come in early December and independent of snow. It doesn't, however.

Temperature Changes
Under the circumstances, it seems to me far more likely that the change in coat is due to changes in temperature brought on by the arrival of cold weather. Sometimes intense cold precedes snow by several days. If a temperature change is the cause of the change in coat, then that could explain why some weasels seem to make the change within a week from the first snowfall while others seem to take as many as three.

And, just to complicate the matter a little further, so far as light and the pituitary gland are concerned, the weasel is primarily a nocturnal animal, doing most of his hunting at night.

City Police Find Abandoned Vehicle

An apparently abandoned vehicle registered to a Waldo G. Davis, U.S. Coast Guard, was discovered on East Jackson st. near the Bear Creek bridge, Medford police reported Friday.

The vehicle's trunk contained several unopened Christmas packages, police reported. A patrolman checked the vehicle after an unknown complainant reported it to the station. He told of finding a lot of litter and paper inside it, including letters addressed to "Walt Davis, U.S. CG Wachusett, c/o Postmaster, Seattle" from someone named "Suzie" in San Francisco.

Keys and registration certificate were missing, he said. On the Christmas packages were cards "To Stephen from the Trustons" and "To Stephen from Santa Claus," he added.

The vehicle, a 1952 or 1953 grey Ford with Washington license SJB198, was reported to motor vehicle authorities at that state. The reply identified the owner as Davis, stationed at Friday Harbor, Wash.

Classes on Soil Principles Set At Courthouse

A series of classes on "soil principles and management for southern Oregon" will be held in the courthouse auditorium beginning Saturday, Jan. 10, according to County Agent C. B. Cordy.

Instructors for the series of six classes will be Dr. M. D. Dawson, associate professor of soils; Arthur S. King, conservation specialist; and Marvin Shearer, irrigation specialist. All are on the Oregon State college faculty.

The course is open to all persons interested, Cordy said. It is designed "to cover the principles of soil science and plant growth and the application of those principles to; 1) soil and water management including drainage and irrigation; 2) soil acidity and alkalinity including the use of lime and the reclamation of alkali soils; 3) soil fertility including the efficient use of fertilizers; 4) soil tilth and organic matter including crop rotations soil conservation and tillage practices; 5) soil classifications including use of soil survey and soil judging."

The classes will be held from 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. and are designed to "meet the needs of any interested in the practical side of soil management," those in charge reported. Persons interested in college credit for the course can complete the Saturday series of lectures by attending three additional technical sessions to be arranged and by successfully passing prescribed examinations.

The course is conducted by the general extension division of the state system of higher education and the cooperative agricultural extension service. A \$10 registration fee will be charged for the six sessions.

A fee of \$27 will be charged those who finish the course for college credit.

Cordy said his office hopes registration will be completed with the county agent before Jan. 10, so no classroom time will be used for enrollment.
