

Fire Damages Eugene School

Eugene - UP - Fire Wednesday caused small damage to the audio-visual room in the basement of Woodrow Wilson Junior high school here.

Only last Wednesday a fire in the gymnasium caused \$15,000 damage and, according to Fire Marshal Lester Barker, was the work of an arsonist.

A burned match was found in the audio-visual room under a cardboard sign which had been ignited. The fire was put out by Charles Stevens, a custodian.

Barker revealed that during the holidays someone had tried to set fire to the gym door. He said wax paper covered with lighter fluid was found near the door.

Vice principal John Menefee also said that on or about Dec. 17 someone had ignited the stage curtain in the gym. He said that a hole about 18 inches in diameter was found on Dec. 18 burned in the curtain.

School officials and members of the PTA were to meet tonight to discuss fire safety plans and fire precaution.

Graham Undergoes Intensive Tests

Rochester, Minn. - UP - Doctors scheduled a third day of intensive tests today on evangelist Billy Graham, 40, who has been advised to slow down.

Physicians at the Mayo Clinic diagnosed Graham's recent left eye ailment Wednesday as a muscular reaction to nervous tension. They received assurances of cooperation from friends of the gospel preacher.

Grady Wilson, tour manager and Graham's assistant, said the evangelist would probably follow orders to rest for a month before starting a planned crusade in Australia Feb. 15.

The crusade, originally set for Feb. 8, was postponed a week when eye spasms and head pains forced Graham to cancel a speaking engagement and fly to Minnesota from Dallas, Tex., last week.
