**The Medical Roundup**

Recently, Dr. James R. Hill, a rectal specialist at the Mayo Clinic, wrote that each year in this country some 10,000 people die of cancer of the rectum. A man (more often than a woman), often in his 50s or 60s will perhaps become constipated for the first time in his life. He may begin to bleed from the bowel, or he may begin to have pain in his pelvis, or a feeling after his bowels move that there still is some material left. With such symptoms he should have immediately insisted on a physician's looking into his rectum with a lighted tube, but he did not know his danger, and hence nothing was done until it was too late.

As Dr. Hill said, from 70 to 80 per cent of the cancers of the large bowel are in the rectum and the sigmoid segment which is just above the rectum; and in this region a lump or an ulcer can easily be seen. Often the cancer starts in what is called a "precancerous polyp", which may have been present for years. Such a polyp which looks sometimes like a mushroom can be burned off with electric sparks, applied with an electrode which is passed down through the lighted tube.

**Dr. Diebel to Talk At School Meeting**

Dr. Clarence Diebel, professor of science at Southern Oregon college, will speak at a meeting of the Jackson County Classroom Teachers at Howard school at 8 p.m. Monday. The program will feature the teaching of science.

Following Dr. Diebel's talk, the group will divide into primary, intermediate, upper grades and high school units.

Miss Irene Hollenbeck, science professor at Southern Oregon college, will lead the upper grades and high school units; Miss Alyce Young, Rogue River school, intermediate group; and Mrs. Jean Long, Jacksonville school, will handle the primary group.

All Jackson county teachers are welcome to the meeting, officials said. The February meeting will feature social studies, specifically the Oregon Centennial.

**So. Oregon Mills Enjoy Bigger Market**

Portland - Bubbling with confidence, Oregon's green fur mills enjoyed a "frothy" market last week at rising prices, according to Crow's Lumber Market News Service. The strength has continued to come from California, as a result of reduced freight rates which have enabled southern Oregon mills to enjoy part of that big market. Buying from the Midwest and East has been about what would be expected at this season, following snow and cold in the nation's mid-section.

Standard and better grade green fur dimension for California is bringing the southern Oregon mills \$8 to \$8 over what eastern buyers are willing to pay. Utility grade continues strong, also. Boards have moved up price-wise in the California market.

Kiln-drying mills are also in a strong position. Low grade 2x4s have been active, and wider widths of utility dimension have begun to move better. This segment of the business is not as zippy as the green department because California does not buy as much kiln-dried lumber as green.
