

### Sailor Dies As Doctor Nears Ship

Los Angeles—The Navy and Coast Guard lost a desperate battle against time Tuesday when a 48-year-old sailing sailor died just minutes before help arrived.

Francis J. Byrne, 48, of Arcadia, was stricken 650 miles out at sea aboard the merchant ship Hawaiian Builder on a voyage to Hawaii. There was no doctor aboard and the ship began a hasty return to Southern California in an attempt to get Byrne to a doctor.

High winds prevented a helicopter sent to meet the ship from removing Byrne and a Navy ship carrying a doctor was about to rendezvous with the merchant vessel when Byrne died. His ship had traveled back to within 60 miles of the California coast in the attempt to save his life.

Cause of death was unknown.

### A Sore Coccyx (Tail Bone)

Quite a few highly nervous or poorly-adjusted people complain bitterly of pain or distress around their coccyx—the little tail bone. A woman just writes to say she has had it treated by regular physicians, also osteopaths and chiropractors who have massaged it and manipulated it and injected it with procaine. They have given her medicines, and still the thing distresses her constantly. Now, a surgeon is planning to remove the bone, thinking that this should surely help. I hope the surgeon first reads up on this operation and learns that it has a reputation for being practically 100 per cent futile. In my 53 years of practice, I have seen quite a few women (the patients are all women) who had this operation done, and none got any relief.

The reason for this failure is that in these cases the disease is not in the tail-bone or the tissues about it—it is the nervous system and probably up in the brain. I have always been impressed by the fact that in these cases, when I moved the little tail-bone back and forth and palpated the joint between the bone and the sacrum just above it (the sacrum is the bone which lies between the two hip bones) I
