

Beck Jury To Hear Federal Agents

Tacoma, Wash. (UPI)—The last three government witnesses in the Dave Beck income tax evasion trial were slated to testify here today.

They will follow the more than 100 witnesses already heard since the trial began last Nov. 10. It was twice postponed during the holidays because of the former Teamster president's poor health. Beck is being tried in Federal District Court here on charges of

evading \$240,000 in income taxes for 1950 through 1953. The final government witnesses are agents of the Internal Revenue Bureau.

In testimony Monday, Fred Loomis, investment counsel, said that in 1948 Beck told him that he had neglected to pay taxes on a \$22,000 income he received in 1947. Beck indicated that his partner, who was not named, had paid the

The Medical Roundup

Remodeling of Breasts
I just got a most grateful letter from a woman who writes that after seeing my article in Good Housekeeping

six months ago, she decided that she would have her very large heavy breasts cut down to normal size. She went to a plastic surgeon and now she is happy because her breasts are normal, and for the first time in her adult life she can dress stylishly, and be satisfied with her figure. She can use her arms comfortably as she never could before, and her shoulders are no longer sore from the tight bra straps.

Another grateful person writes me that no one but a woman could understand the mental suffering which she endured for years with breasts that were not much bigger than those of a man. She took courage from reading my article, and went and had her breasts pushed forward by a sort of "false" — made of plastic — which was inserted between the breast tissue and her chest wall. A few surgeons have of late had the courage to keep studying the difficult problems involved in finding some soft substance for a "false" — one that will remain soft, will not become hard and lumpy, will not shrink greatly, and will not become infected. The plastic first used were so unsatisfactory that, in most cases, the insert had to be removed at a second operation.

At last a plastic has been found which usually works well. Because the insert tends to shrink, the surgeon must put in one perhaps twice as large as desirable. Dr. John Pangman, of Beverly Hills, who for several years has been working on this problem, said that in 1958 he was lucky, and did not have to take out a single one of the inserts. I admire Dr. Pangman's courage and devotion in working on this procedure, because always there is the certainty that some woman, when she does not wind up looking exactly like Venus de Milo, will use him for big damages. She will ask the judge and jury not to pay any attention to the document she signed before the operation, in which she stated that she was so desperately unhappy over her small breasts that she demanded that the operation be attempted.

She said that the surgeon had warned her about all the dangers: He had told her that the technic had not been worked out in every detail; that accidents could easily happen, and that the first insert put in might have to be removed. She will play down the fact that to all of these warnings she had turned a deaf ear, and had gone on begging for help.

Perhaps she had been left satisfied and happy with the result, but her husband, seeing a chance of "making a quick buck" and getting for himself several thousands of dollars, had sued. These are the dangers that every pioneer in surgery must run.

Partly because of these dangers, and partly because they have had no personal experience with this new technic, many plastic surgeons do not care to do this type of work. But often they can help the woman by putting her in the hands of a man willing and competent to perform the operation. Women wanting this type of work done should remember that without proper guidance it is possible to get into the hands of an incompetent operator.

I have seen letters from some of the women who have been operated on successfully for flat breasts and were so grateful they didn't know what to do. They said that at last life was worth living. At last they could go out in a bathing suit. Interestingly, some of the young actresses in Beverly Hills said that since a plastic operation has given them a good bust, their bookings have been much better than ever before!

Electroshock Treatments
Many persons when told to have electroshock treatments are worried and fearful. They want to know if the treatments will hurt, or if they are dangerous or will do harm. The treatment should not hurt because the instant the current comes on, the person is unconscious. Some doctors give the treatment without any preliminary anesthesia, while others, and especially when dealing with a very apprehensive patient, will first inject into a vein a little sodium pentothal. With this, the patient is unconscious for a while. I have seen many persons who had shock treatments, and especially when they had only from four to eight, and with these got well, there were no bad effects besides a temporary loss of some memory. In my limited experience, it has seemed that when a person did not get better with a half-dozen treatments it did not do any good to go on to give him 20 or 30.

Some of my psychiatric friends give the treatment in their office. Others give the treatments in a room in the out-patient department of a hospital. In either case in an hour or so a relative can take the patient home. This greatly cuts down on the expense which results when a patient is hospitalized.

In cases of schizophrenia, insulin shock treatments are often used instead of electroshocks. Dr. Alvarez hopes his readers will understand that it would be impossible for him to answer requests for information or attempt to diagnose by mail. (Released by The Register and Tribune Syndicate, 1959)
