RECORD-WISE, the New Year is just beginning, and the initial releases, you will find, are very appropriate for Valentine Day. Why not give your favorite gal or guy a musical greeting?

### tops on the record shelves:

"Fancy Meeting You Here" teams two old pros, Rosemary Clooney and Bing Crosby, in a fine RCA effort. For the swing set, there's "Swingin' at the Cinema," Capitol's Jonah Jones offering. In the jazz vein, try "Impressions of Eurasia," by Dave Brubeck and his quartet on Columbia. Delibes' "Coppelia," with the complete ballet recorded by the Minneapolis Symphony on Mercury, and Stokowski's "The String Orchestra" on Capitol are truly valentines edged in musical lace.

### music for family listening:

Let's start off with the vocalists, who have some good platters this month. Disneyland offers "Mary Martin Sings a Musical Love Story"; from RCA comes "Smoochin' Time" by the Ames Brothers, and "Lou Monte Sings," an especially good waxing for the whole family; "Sing a Song of Italy" by Toni Arden, and "The Swinging Aces" featuring the Four Aces are Decca's entries; Capitol brings us "Things Are Swinging" by pretty Peggy Lee and "The Very Thought of You" by Nat "King" Cole. Finally, from MGM, try "I Love You" by Joni James, "It's All in the Game" starring Tommy Edwards, and "Hello, Tiger" by a new singer, Sallie Blair.

### covering the classics:

A must for every classicist is "The Composer and His Orchestra," a Mercury etching by Howard Hanson and the Eastman-Rochester Orchestra, which clearly explains the entire make-up of the symphony. From Angel comes "Love Duets" with Rosanna Carteri and Giuseppe DiStefano singing some of your favorite opera arias.

Capitol offers Rimsky-Korsakov's suite from "Le Coq D'or" and Prokofiev's suite from "Love for Three Oranges" by the Pittsburgh Symphony Orchestra. The complete "Chocolate Soldier" starring Jo Sullivan, Peter Palmer, and other fine singers is presented by RCA.

### jazzomania:

Bufs are discovering a new group, the Metropolitan Jazz Quartet; now, via MGM, this group has five new albums on the market to showcase their talents. Each package is devoted to a famous theme, such as the classics, great Broadway shows, foreign movies, American movies, and TV shows. Also of interest are two Warner Brothers items, "N.Y. Export: Jazz from Ballets U.S.A." by Robert Prince, and "Funky Piano, New Orleans Style" by Alton Purnell.

"Something Else!" is a real gasser by Ornette Coleman, a most talented musician cutting for Contemporary. "Fabulous Phineas" could only be Phineas Newborn and his trio on RCA, while "Lover Man" is Decca's showcase for Billie Holiday. "Duke Ellington at the Cotton Club" is Camden's \$1.98 bargain package.

### special merit:

For the kiddies, Disney presents "This Was the West" by Stan Jones and "Sleeping Beauty," told and sung by Mary Martin. Hi-fi fans will want "Mallet Mischief" by Harry Breuer on Audio Fidelity.



### stereo sound-off:

The new sound now has some fine pop sides available, including "Crazy People," with Somethin' Smith on Epic; "Love Among the Young," Jennie Smith, Columbia; "Jimmie McHugh in Hi-Fi," Urbie Green and his orchestra, and "Bang, Bar-room, and Harp," both on RCA.
