

Change in Rules Makes Filing of Federal Income Tax Return Easier

If your income was \$5,000 or more, you must compute your own tax and use the standard deduction. If you find you owe more than was withheld by your employer, you must pay the difference with your return.

You cannot wait for the Government to send you a bill.

Make your check or money order payable to "Internal Revenue Service" and mail it with your return to your District Director of Internal

Rules for Filing

Short Income Tax Form

Washington - (UPI) - You may file your income tax return on the short form, 1040A, if your income (or combined income in a joint return) was less than \$10,000 in 1958 and included not more than \$200 in dividends, interest or wages not subject to withholding.

But even if you meet this test, you may not use the short form if you itemize deductions, claim head of household status, are a non-resident alien or fall into certain other categories. If in doubt, check with your nearest Internal Revenue Service office.

Revenue. There is at least one district in each state and you can find his address on the inside of the Form 1040 tax instruction booklet.

Be sure to include with tax return - regardless of whether you use Form 1040A or Form 1040 - copy B of all your W-2 withholding statements. We must have these with your return or it is incomplete.

Taxpayers who may not use the card form - and who must, therefore, file on the long Form 1040 - include those who have wage or salary income of \$10,000 or more, or more than \$200 of other income; those who wish to itemize their deductions because they exceed the standard 10 per cent automatically allowed every taxpayer; and those who claim a sick pay exclusion or head of household status.

One Major Change

If you file Form 1040, you'll notice one major change concerning reporting of business expenses. Line 6 (a) has been dropped. Instead, near the bottom of page 1, you'll find these two questions, each followed by "yes" and "no" boxes. "Did you receive an expense allowance or reimbursement, or charge expenses to your employer?" If "yes," did you submit an itemized accounting of expenses to your employer?"

Should you answer the first question "no," you're saying you had no expense account or allowance and had no expenses for which you asked the boss for reimbursement.

But, if the answer is yes, then your answer to the next question is very important. If you DID account to your employer for your expense money, and he paid you exactly what you spent, you don't have to tell the Internal Revenue Service anything more than that.

But if you did NOT account to your boss for your expense money, the Revenue Service wants to know how much you received and how much you actually spent. You do this by including your reimbursements advances and other allowances in your income tax return. Then you must furnish a statement with your return listing the information

requested in the Form 1040 instruction pamphlet. You may be asked, too, to produce hotel bills and restaurant tabs.

Difference Taxable

If you received more expense money than you actually laid out, the difference is taxable. If you claim a deduction for an excess of expenses over reimbursements, you must itemize ALL ex-

penses.

Form 1040 filers must list their non-wage and salary income - such as dividends, interest, rent, capital gains - in the appropriate places on page 3 of the form. They compute their tax from the rate tables on page 15 of the form.

For help in preparing your return you may consult the district office or the nearest

field office of the Internal Revenue Service. It helps you (and may save you time) if you telephone first. If your problem is too complicated to be answered over the phone, come in person to our nearest office. There is no charge for consultation, either in person or over the phone.

Hung Jury Ends Homicide Trial

Hillsboro - (UPI) - The negligent homicide trial of Leo Vernon Brown, 24, Gaston, ended in a hung jury here Friday night after six hours of deliberation.

Brown was indicted by the Washington county grand jury for the deaths of August J. Strassel, 42, Portland, Linda, his 9-year-old daughter and Donna Jean DeFreitas, 21. The girl and Miss DeFreitas died in a Portland hospital as a result of burns suffered when the Strassel station wagon became engulfed in flames.

The prosecution contended

that Brown was intoxicated and driving at high speed when his car ran into the rear of a station wagon operated by Strassel on Highway 8 west of Beaverton last August 10.

Circuit Court Judge Glen Hieber said the case will be retried as soon as the court calendar permits.

Portland - (UPI) - Mrs. Lola Helena Bourgoyne, 79, of Portland, was dead on arrival at Providence hospital here late Friday after being struck by a car in northeast Portland.

Police said driver of the car was Priscilla A. Gardner, 30, of Portland. She told officers she did not see the victim until she was directly in front of the car.

Mrs. Bourgoyne was thrown about 30 feet by the impact, police said.

Mrs. Bourgoyne is survived by four sons; the Rev. W. Sherman Bourgoyne, retired pastor of the University Park

Methodist Church; Lester H. Bourgoyne, Eugene branch manager for Fuller Brush Company, Norman, St. Helens; and Leonard, Salem.

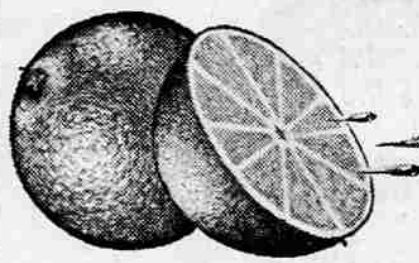

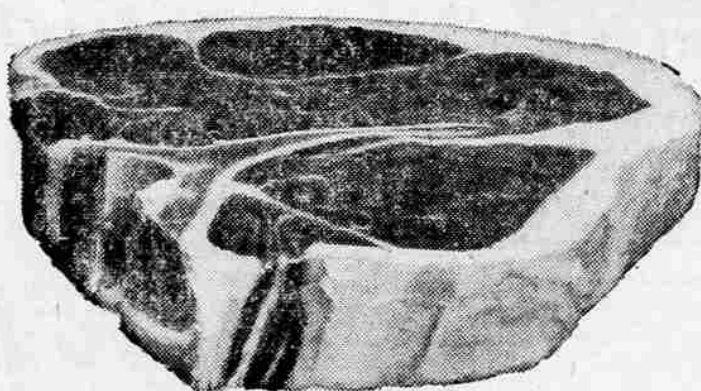
