The Gaels can nail down their first West Coast Athletic conference title and an NCAA berth with a victory over College of Pacific tonight. California, on the other hand, needs at least two more wins to clinch a tie for the Pacific Coast Conference title and its third straight PCC crown.

College of Pacific still has a mathematical chance of tying St. Mary's for the WCAC crown. But past records indicate that tonight's contest will serve only as a formal claim to the championship by St. Mary's.

Roseburg Quintet Wins District AAU Playoff

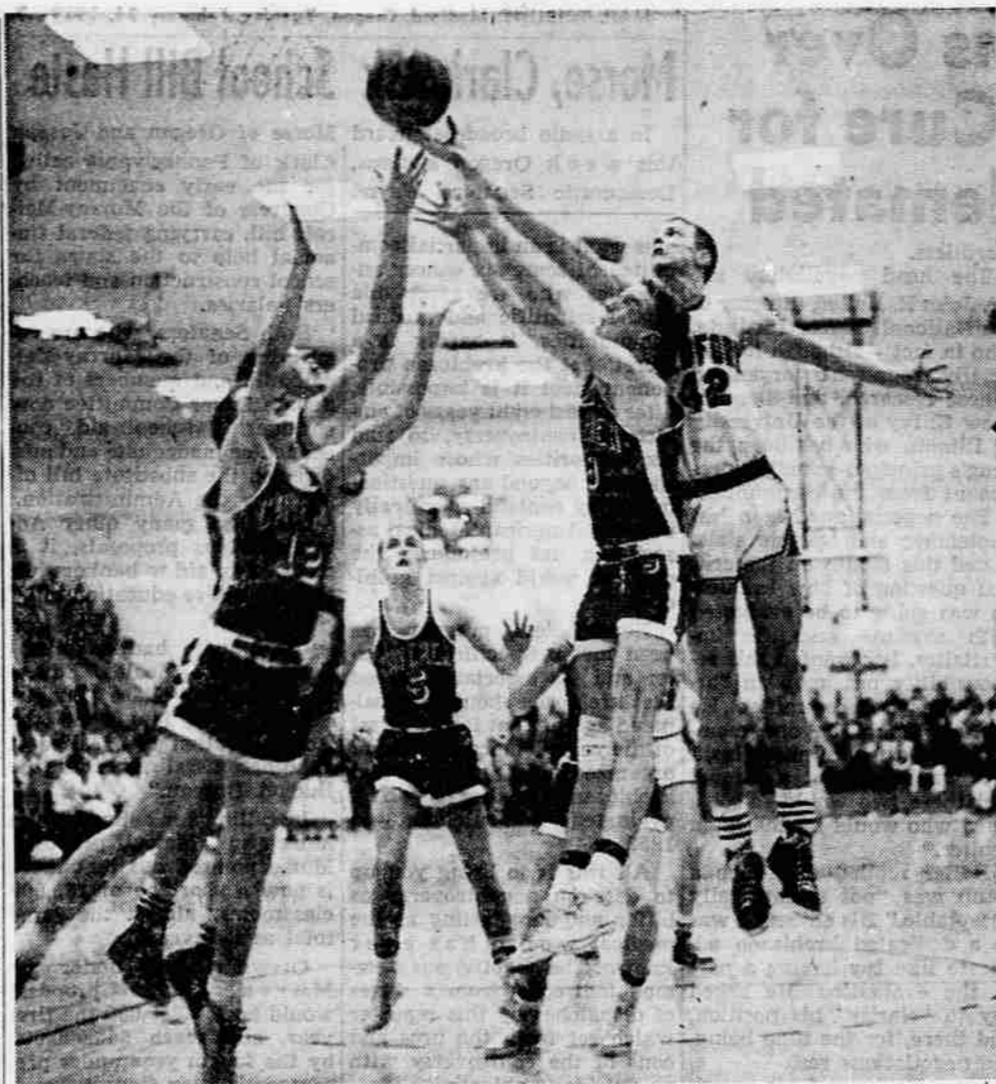
