



Construction of Forest Products Pavilion Starts

Portland - Construction began here today on the \$250,000 Oregon Forest Products pavilion which will shelter 24,000 square-feet of displays at the Oregon Centennial Exposition and International Trade Fair.

The pavilion is of a striking design unlike any other building of its kind in the world.

The futuristic wood structure, to rise at the heart of the Centennial Exposition grounds, will be used as a pavilion to display to millions of visitors the use of forest products in modern living. The building will remain following close of the 1959 Exposition as a permanent structure and will be donated to the 4-H clubs of Oregon.

Seven Parabolooids
The huge building will consist of seven sweeping hyperbolic parabolooids, each 50 feet square, supported at just six points.

Most unusual feature of the pavilion is that it is designed to be constructed completely of wooden 1x8's. Each of the 50-foot squares will be laminated from two layers of the 1x8's. Although hyperbolic parabolooids have been used in building designs before, it is believed that the Oregon Forest Products building will be the first to use as many as seven parabolooids.

The unique sweeping structure was designed by Portland architect John Storrs. Roy Gould, general chairman of the Forest Industries Centennial committee, pointed out that this particular design was approved for the pavilion because it demonstrates new uses for wood in architecture.

Adjacent to the building will be constructed a tree farm demonstrating the forest industry's program to provide perpetual tree resources.

Financing of the pavilion is being voluntarily underwritten by all segments of the industry "from the logger to the supplier of industry equipment and service," according to Gould. Chairman of the finance committee was A. A. (Tony) Lausmann, Medford lumberman.

Cost of the pavilion and grounds complete and ready for displays, is estimated at \$105,000. An additional \$145,000 is budgeted to build the exhibits inside and outside the pavilion and to staff and maintain the exhibits for the 100 days of the Centennial Exposition.

Dulles Confident Of Return To Job

Washington -UPI- Secretary of State John Foster Dulles was reported confident today that his cancer treatments will permit him to return to his State Department desk.

Phyllis Bernau, Dulles' chief secretary, quoted him as telling her he was going to resume his official duties.

"He did say that?" reporters pressed her.

"Yes, indeed he did," she replied.

Miss Bernau said she and three other girls from Dulles' office who took the secretary a present in his 71st birthday Wednesday did not ask him when he would be back.

The aide said Dulles was "feeling pretty good" in his room at Walter Reed Army Hospital. "We had lots of good laughs with him. He was quite sharp as a matter of fact. He was full of beans."

Dulles will receive another dose of radiation today from the hospital's million-volt X-ray machine.

Ingrid Bergman To Attend Oscar Show

Hollywood -UPI- Actress Ingrid Bergman will return here in April for the Academy Award presentations, ending a 10-year voluntary exile from filmland.

Producer Jerry Wald, in charge of the television production of the Oscar awards program, said Wednesday night the Swedish-born actress would be accompanied here by her third husband, Lars Schmidt, whom she married this year.

Wald said Miss Bergman will make the Academy Award presentation to the best male actor of the year at the April 5 show and English actor Alec Guinness will present the award for the best actress.

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
