

Interest-Free Loans To Klamaths Eyed

Portland (UPI)—The Interior Department said Thursday it is proposing legislation to Congress allowing the Bureau of Indian Affairs to make loans without interest to Indians who are withdrawing from the Klamath tribe.

A news release quoted Assistant Secretary Roger Ernst as saying such loans were justified because sales of tribal forest lands to compensate the 1959 withdrawing members will be made under existing laws over a two-year period starting April 1. This delay in sales procedure means that withdrawing members will not get the larger portion of their money until sometime in 1960 and 1961.

The Department said that because the delay was due to no fault of the Indians it proposed to make non-interest-bearing loans to them from the revolving credit fund of the Bureau of Indian Affairs. Loans would be collected from proceeds of sale of tribal property.

Former Ashland Resident Killed

Bend (UPI)—A former Ashland man was killed here Thursday when his car struck the rear of a truck.

The victim was Lloyd Roman Fassett, 39. Police said both the car and the truck, driven by Lonnie M. Chapman, 26, Harrah, Okla., were southbound through the city on Highway 97 when the accident occurred.

Fassett was dead when an ambulance arrived. He was alone in the car. The accident occurred at 1:40 a.m.

Fassett formerly lived at 143 Hargadine st., Ashland, but recently had stayed with his mother here. It was the first traffic fatality here since July 1, 1957.
