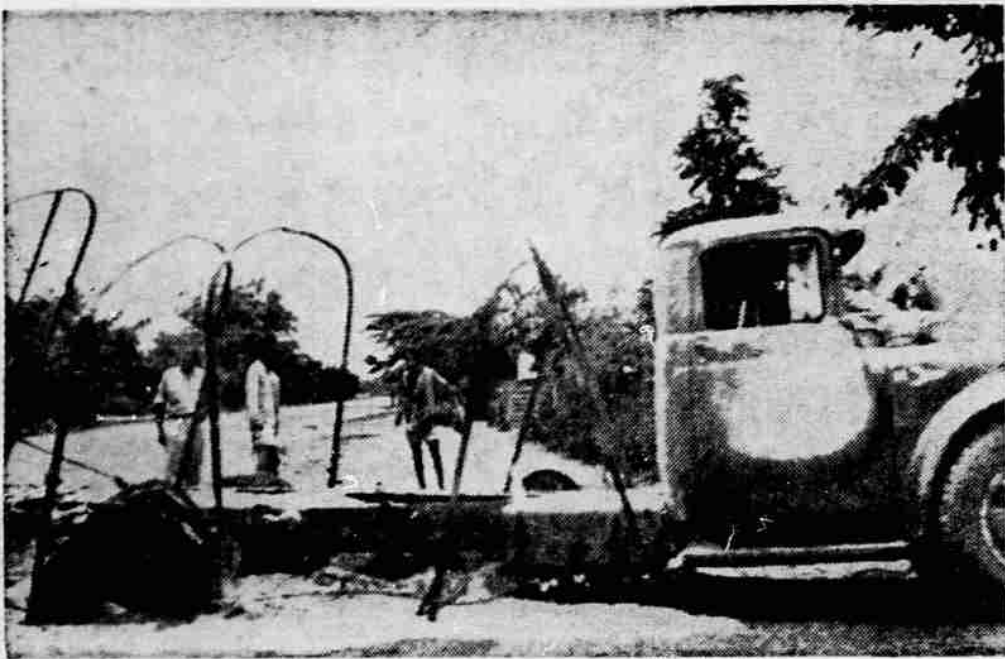

Cubbers' Pow-Wow Scheduled Sunday At Hedrick School

"A fun-filled frolic" is the description given to the annual Cubbers' Pow Wow by Paul Gasparotti, chairman of the special Cub Scout event to be held from 1 to 5 p.m. Sunday at Hedrick Junior High school.

The training event is offered to all leaders of Cub Scouts packs by the leadership training committee of the Crater Lake Council, Boy Scouts of America.

"A pow wow prepares leaders to return to their own Cub Scout pack with knowledge and experience in games, handicraft, ceremonies, entertainment, and administration," Gasparotti explained. "All this means better Cub Scouting, and it's a major step toward the scout's key or the den mother's award which recognize trained adults registered in scouting."

Cub Scout packs will bring games for a "midway" under the direction of Myron Hollen of Pack 1, sponsored by the Knight of Columbus.

The pow wow will be divided into five sections in order to provide specialized training for all Cub Scout leaders, Gasparotti said.

The "administration" section will be conducted by Joe Killingsworth, Cubmaster of Pack 41, sponsored by the Griffin Creek Mother's club. The section is for Cubmasters, committee chairmen, and institutional representatives.

The "ceremonies and entertainment" section will be for awards committeemen and den mothers and will be led by Elba O. Graham, institutional representative of Pack 35, sponsored by the First Presbyterian church of Jacksonville.

The "games" section is recommended for assistant cubmasters and den mothers and will be headed by Mike Morris of the Big Pines district training staff and Mark Axtell, neighborhood commissioner in the Roaring Rogue district, Grants Pass.

The "crafts" section will give actual craft experiences and ideas for den mothers and is being arranged by Mrs. Pat Ford and six other den mothers from the Big Pines district.

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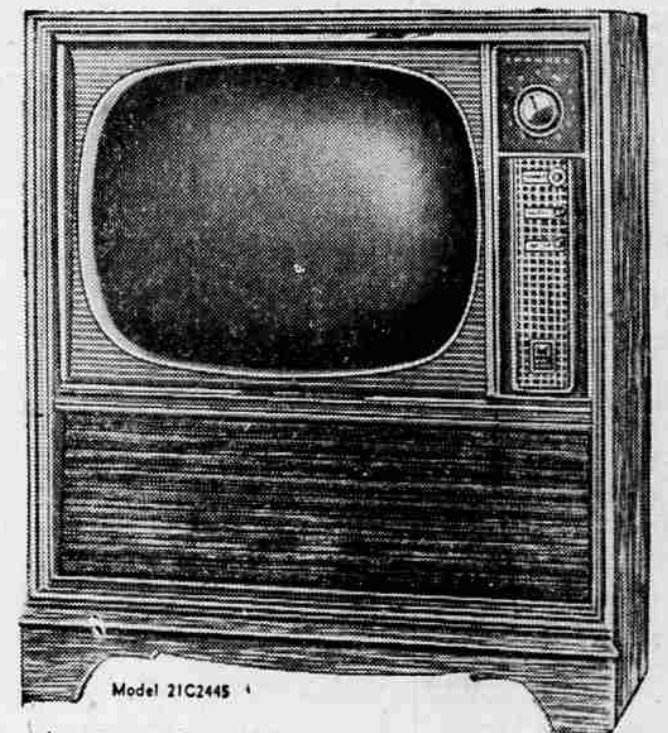


The stand is brass and natural wood—Oriental modern. This stand goes with the set at the price of the set alone.

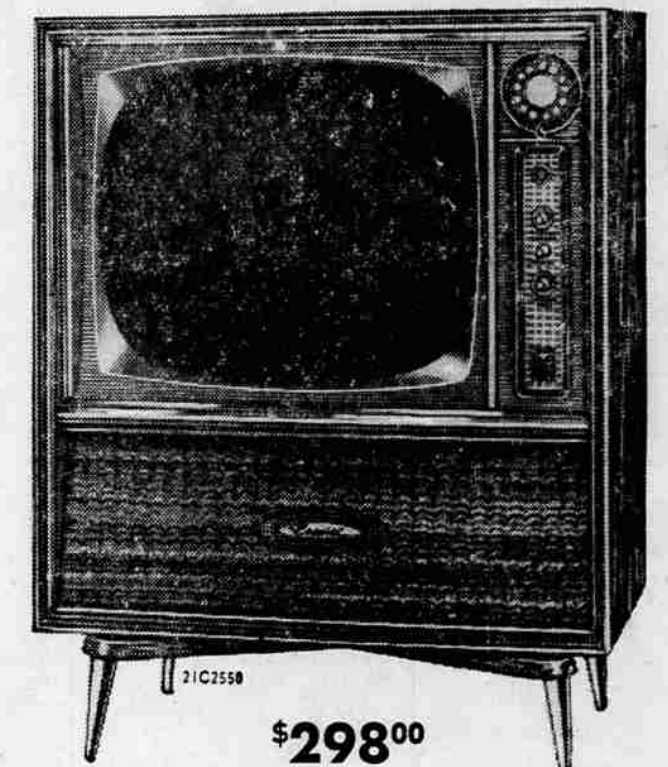
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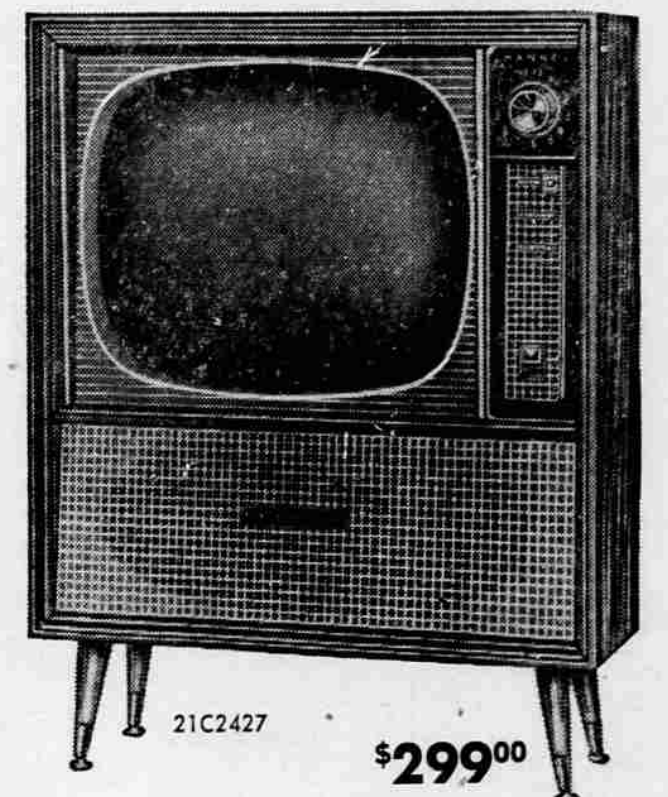
The price includes the base for the first time this year. (It's a table model that looks like a console.)



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
