Truman Will Be Trail Master for Centennial Train

Portland — (UP) — Former President Harry Truman says he lacks experience as a "bull-whip cracker" but will do what he can to get Oregon's Centennial wagon train rolling out of Independence, Mo., April 19.

Centennial officials said Truman, replying to an invitation by Sen. Richard L. Neuberger and Rep. Charles O. Porter to be honorary trail master, said:

"I am very much interested in that program. I sincerely hope it will be possible for me to be present and help with the celebration.

Practice Lacking
"I doubt very much if I would be a good trail master. I was informed by my grandfather that a trail master must be able to pop a 20-foot bull whip and kill a fly without hurting the animal. I have never had any practice along that line and I don't know whether I could do it.

"But if there is anything I can do to help make your start here in Independence agreeable and acceptable, I'll be glad to do it."

The train of six wagons carrying 30 persons is expected to cover the 2,000 miles from Independence, Mo., to Independence, Ore., in 130 days, covering 20 miles a day.

Power Tie Study Committee Urged

Salem — (UP) — Representatives of Oregon, Washington and California are agreed that a study committee should be formed to investigate the feasibility of a power intertie among the three states.

Representatives of key power and resource agencies of the three states gathered at the request of Gov. Mark Hatfield to make recommendations on the proposed power intertie.

Hatfield's administrative assistant, Warne Nunn, said a 1953 Federal Power Commission study showed that there would be "overwhelming benefits" from a power tie-in.
