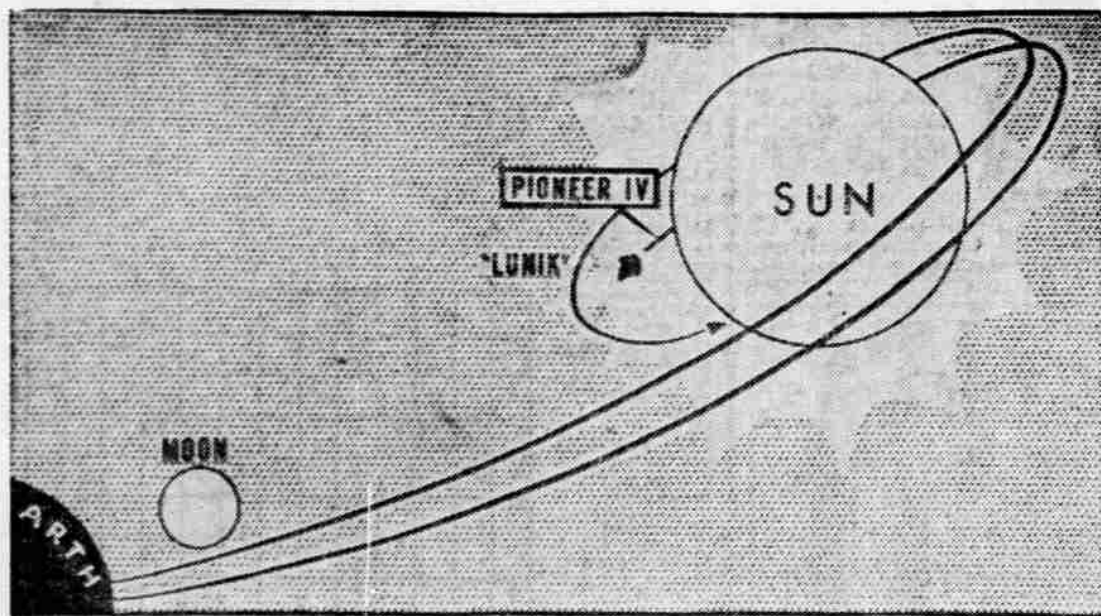

The Family Council Pioneer IV May Be Lost Forever, Astronomer Says

Shelley R. — I want to tell our parents about Stan.

Stanley R. — Does she think I'm going to take orders?

Shelley R. — I am so upset about my brother Stanley, who has gotten involved with one of my best friends.

Stan is 28 and has always been quite a Don Juan. The girls really go for him. I have often warned my girl friends against him because he has no scruples at all. I was really upset when my friend Isabella fell for him so hard. But then I began to think it was working out because he seemed to care about her. Well, I guess I'm mistaken because I learned the other day that they are having an affair, and when I asked Stan if he is planning to marry Isabella he laughed at me.

I am furious that he should do a thing like this to such a lovely girl. I am thinking of letting my parents know what a cad they've introduced into the world. Maybe they can do something with him.

Stanley R. — Miss Tattle Tale thinks she is still age 6 and I'm 10, and she can run my life by running off to tell Mommy and Daddy when I do things she doesn't like. Where does she come off with that stuff? Does she really think I'm going to take orders?

There are a lot of things in life my sweet little sister doesn't understand. This "lovely girl" Isabella actually threw herself at me and wouldn't take no for an answer. Shelley doesn't believe it, but half the things she blames me for have happened just about like that. I may flirt with girls, but it takes a lot more than that to make a situation.

I think Shelley pokes her nose into my affairs entirely too much. She has no serious boy friends of her own and keeps trying to find out things about me.

Prison Inmates Get Stock Shares

Honolulu — (UPI) — Eight Oahu, Hawaii, prison inmates have been made stockholders in the Hawaiian Dredging and Construction company by a Frenchman they do not know.

Each convict is getting five stock shares, or an estimated \$800 worth. The recipients of the stock are each serving a maximum term of at least 60 years.

The shares are the gift of Lee P. Warren of Nice, France. No one is quite sure why Warren, a former company employee, has given stocks to the convicts, but conjecture hereabouts is that he was playing a joke on his former employers.

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Possibly Shelley is a little over-concerned about his private affairs, but Stanley ought to recognize that she can't help looking up to him somewhat as an ideal. Stanley has not only smeared this ideal image Shelley carries in her heart, but has confused her about her own values. Probably she childishly hopes her parents will somehow restore order to the chaotic state of her own mind and feelings.

If Stanley remains uninfluenced by his sister's concern, we can only recommend that Shelley remove herself from his life and affairs as fully as possible. She should find her own groups of friends and avoid merging them with her brother and his friends. She should stick to her own values and remember that she is not responsible for the morality of either her brother or her girl friends. Presumably they are old enough to make their own choices.

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Cambridge, Mass. — (Science Service) — The solar system's second artificial planet, now going into orbit around the sun, will soon be lost for many years, probably forever.

Dr. J. Allen Hynek, associate director of the Smithsonian Astrophysical Observatory here, said the chances of seeing the baby planet again, even with powerful telescopes, were "very small." He said the 13.4 - pound, gold-plated satellite would be officially named Artificial Planet Two, but that it is much too tiny and too faint to be rediscovered.

Called Asteroids

Tiny planets such as the two artificial ones now orbiting the sun are called asteroids by astronomers. The smallest asteroids now observable are about a mile in diameter. At closest approach to earth these faint points of light move so swiftly across the starry heavens that they can easily be missed. Because the new artificial planet, launched by the United States as Pioneer IV on March 3, is so much smaller and fainter, it is highly probable that it will wander unrecorded in space.

If it is ever rediscovered, the chances are high it will be found only by chance, since its orbit through space will not be determined with sufficient accuracy before its radio goes dead. The radio is expected to quit sometime before midnight, Saturday, March 7.

Milan, Italy — (UPI) — Actor Ernest Borgnine and Actress Kati Jurado will be married near Modena or in Rome next month.

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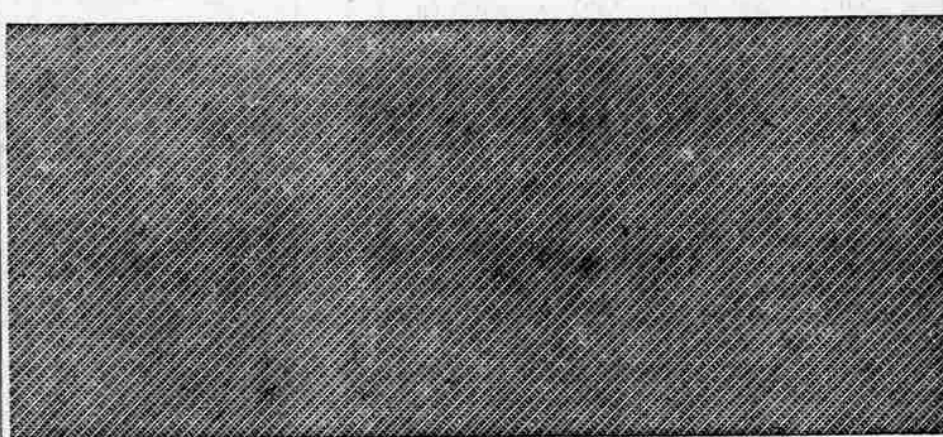
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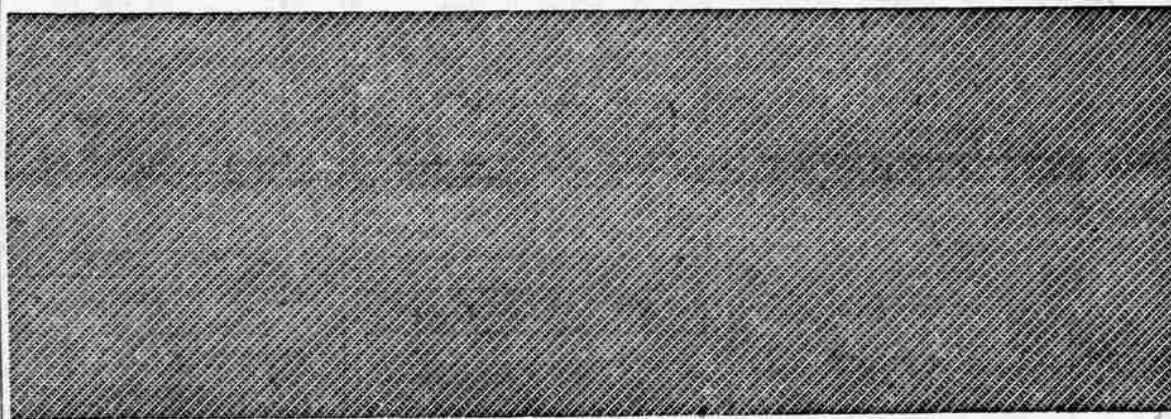
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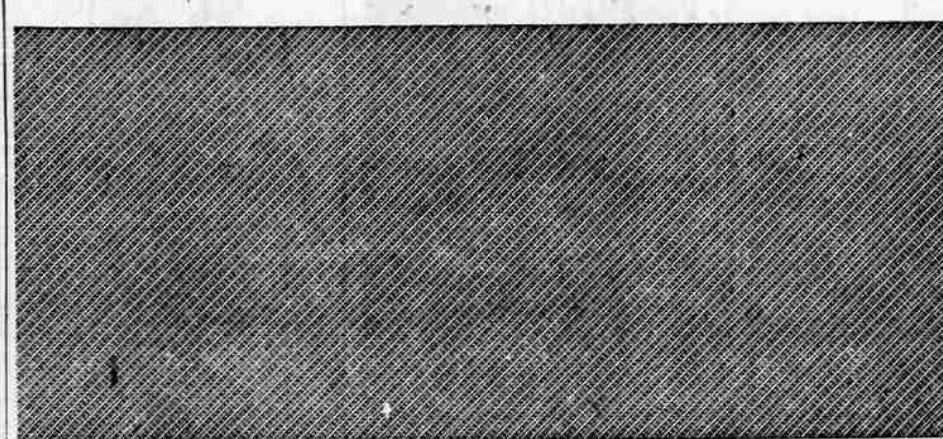
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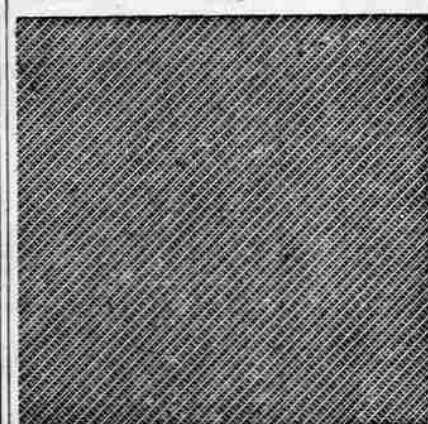
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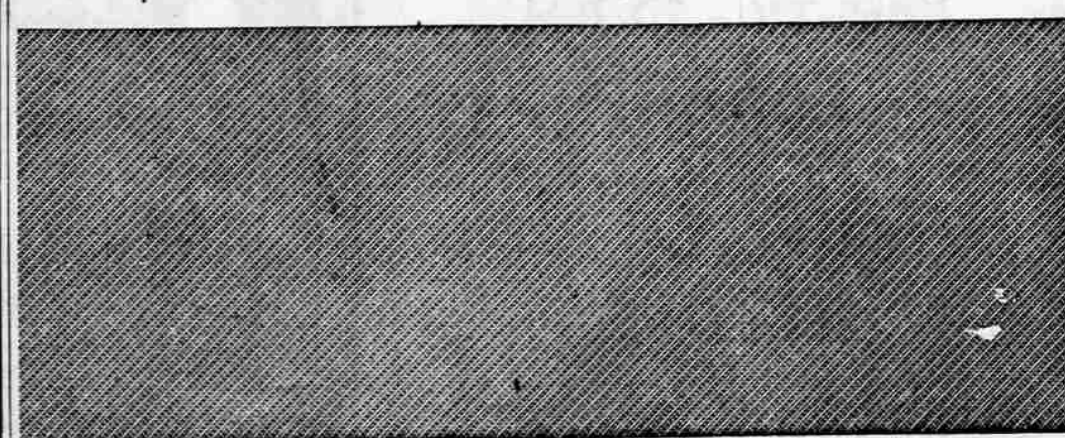
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
