Boys Need A Firm Hand

Every so often a mother brings me a teenage boy who is becoming delinquent; already he is a trouble maker, and he has been arrested a couple of times for stealing or vandalism or truancy, and usually it is obvious that his mother, or perhaps even his father, hasn't the strength or the will to stand up to him, to keep his respect, and to exert some control over him.

Often I find, on talking to the parents, that years ago they swallowed whole some crackpot psychiatric idea that they must never correct or admonish or punish the child for fear of injuring his ego or causing him later to become psychotic.

Now, the psychiatrist, instead of admitting that his stupid advice helped to produce a bit of human wreckage, has the nerve to accuse the parents of having, at some time, tried to put some sense of decency into the child; according to him this is why the child has become delinquent!

No Respect Held
When these boys are brought to me, the main question usually is, has the lad a small dose of the psychosis or epilepsy of an ancestor, or has he just been brought up without any training in self-control, self-discipline or human decency?

All parents with such a problem ought to read and re-read many times an article by Cal Farley in Today's Health, published by the American Medical Association (January, 1958). Farley has for years been running a "Boy's Ranch" and school near Amarillo, Texas. Most of the boys in the school have had some conflict with the law, but the ranch is definitely not a reform school with a high wall around it.

Most of them remain for from four to six years. At the end of that time they are equipped to earn a living in one of several trades. Also, they have learned discipline, and have been taught to adjust well to life. The ranch now accommodates 220 youngsters, but Farley is building facilities to take care of 500. The boys live in dormitories, each run by a fine man and his wife who serve as foster parents. In 20 years, more than 1500 boys have been trained at the ranch. Only 37 were failures. I imagine their brains were so poorly made that there was nothing in the

Mixed March Weather Forecast

Suitland, Md. (Science Service) - The Weather Bureau's 30-day outlook for March calls for temperatures to average below normal from the Great Lakes eastward through New England.

Below normal temperatures are also predicted for the West Gulf states and the far Southwest. Along the West Coast and generally over the northwestern fourth of the nation, temperatures are expected to average above seasonal normals.

In unspecified areas, near to slightly above normal temperatures are expected to prevail. Precipitation is forecast to exceed normal along the Gulf Coast and over the Southeast as well as in the Pacific Northwest. Subnormal amounts are predicted over the Central and Southern Plateau states, southern California, the Northern Plains and the central North Atlantic states.
