Narrowed Arteries Rebuilt

At the recent meeting of the American Heart Association, Dr. Michael E. DeBakey, one of the world's great artery surgeons, reported a study of 957 patients who, in the last five years, have undergone surgery for their arteries. In many cases, arteries supplying the legs with blood were so blocked that the person couldn't walk half a block without getting severe cramps that made him stop and rest for a minute. The surgeon now either cuts out and replaces the diseased segment of artery or he inserts a by-pass graft that keeps the blood flowing. Occasionally, a recently formed blood-clot can be removed.

In about 95 per cent of the cases the circulation was successfully restored by the operation. The long-term results have generally been good. Occasionally, a second operation has had to be performed. This is a wonderful report.

Nowadays, when a person is found to have an aneurysm (a partial blow-out in an ulcerated and weakened segment of one of the big arteries perhaps in his chest or abdomen or leg) the artery surgeon takes out the diseased segment, and replaces it with a good one. Until a few years ago, a man with an aneurysm had to wait, perhaps in such

Licenses of 381 Drivers Suspended

Salem - The department of motor vehicles has released names of 381 drivers whose licenses were ordered suspended during the period beginning Feb. 23, and ending Feb. 27.

Length of suspension varies, depending on charges involved, recommendation of court, discretionary action by the department or requirements of Oregon law, the department said some of the licenses involving court recommendations may have been re-instated after suspension was ordered.

The department warned drivers that the penalty for driving while suspended is a jail sentence of no less than two days and up to six months, and there may be a fine up to \$500. Under licensing procedures, this will also result in an additional year of suspension.

Those suspended in Jackson county were: Driving While Suspended - (Includes any conviction for violation of traffic laws, involving operation of motor vehicle, while driving privileges were under suspension) Brown, Floyd Wilton, 18, of 1110 Ross Lane, Medford, driving while suspended, 1 year.

Discretionary Action of Department Dillon, Jerry Howard, 19, of 333 North Holly St., Medford, driving record, 30 days.

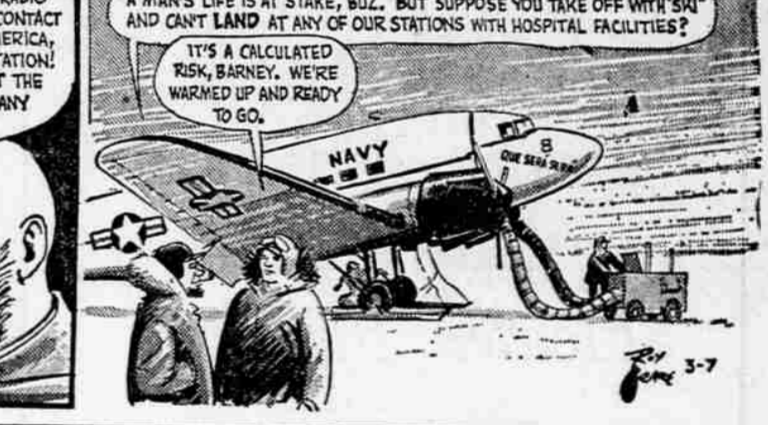
