When Plant Eats Animal - That's News

A dog biting a man long has since ceased to be news - it is only when the action is reversed, and the man bites the dog, is it worthy of a few lines in the daily press. The same formula applies to plants that attack animals.

Ordinarily the animal eats the plant but there are several varieties of plants that "get even" by actually attacking and later eating the animal.

The so-called "pitcher-plant" is the most conspicuous and probably the largest but there are several others growing in roadside ditches, small ponds and at forest edges. Such a one is the "bladderwort," a plant that not only kills and eats the creatures it catches but lures them into the trap. It has been known to trap and eat tadpoles, worms and even small fish.

Bizarre Plant

The leaves of this bizarre plant are divided into fine, fern-like segments. On the stems and roots are tiny bladders, flattened on the bottom and pierced by a round opening. It almost could be called a mouth. Around this opening are many stiff hairs. Small fish, insects, etc., see this opening and think it is a crevice in which to hide. The little creature actually is "jumping out of the frying pan into the fire" for as soon as it enters the opening a tiny "trapdoor" on the inside is pushed up against the opening and the animal is in a "death trap."

Digestive juices of the plant begin work on the victim, reducing it to a food that is absorbed by the tissues of the plant. The little trap-door remains closed until the food is

digested, opening again when the pangs of hunger tell the plant it is time to eat. A small tadpole will last for several days.

The "butterwort," another flesh eating plant, possesses many of the same habits, but add a few gruesome refinements of its own.

Its technique is a little different but it accomplishes the same result. The leaves are long and slender, growing from a common base. On the inner side of each leaf is a sticky substance. Small insects become hopelessly covered with this mucilage-like material. Their struggles to escape stimulate the plant glands to secrete more "glue." At times the leaf itself will curl around the victim, hastening the final end. When dead the insect is acted on by the digestive juice and absorbed by the plant.

These flesh eating plants have been used for experimental purposes in an attempt to find out more about plant behavior. Under actual observation they have been found to do some startling things.

You, too, can observe some behavior traits in these plants that will cause your friends to look askance at what you tell them about plants that accomplish some unbelievable things. You probably have friends who will call you a deliberate spinner of falsehoods.

Condon Lectures Set at Colleges

Eugene - The 1959 Condon lectures will be given at the University of Oregon March 31 and April 2 by Sir Wilfrid E. Le Gros Clark, head of the department of human anatomy at Oxford university, England.

General topic for the lectures will be "The Foundations of Human Evolution." Sir Wilfrid's two lectures will be entitled "The Hypothesis of Human Evolution and its Verification," and "The Preliminary Antecedents of Human Evolution."

The two lectures will be repeated at Oregon State college in Corvallis on April 7 and 9, and at Portland State college on April 14 and 16.

The British evolutionist has published numerous articles and books on his field of study. His most recent book, "The Fossil Evidence for Human Evolution," was published in 1955. He has been associated with Oxford university since 1934.
