The Minnesota Democrat was to have spoken on "people, peace and progress," in the fourth of a series of university lectures. Several announcements on the senator's supposed whereabouts were made at frequent intervals to the audience.

In the interim, Rutgers officials delivered off-the-cuff remarks.

The lecture finally was called off. Later it was learned that Humphrey's plane was delayed in leaving Washington and that when he arrived in New York, there were no connections to get him to New Brunswick in time. He returned to Washington.

S. F. Reserve Bank Ups Discount Rate

San Francisco - (UP) - The San Francisco Reserve Bank has been authorized by the Federal Reserve Board to raise its discount rate to 3 per cent from 2½ per cent, effective Friday.

The action was taken by the bank's directors at a meeting in Salt Lake City, Utah.

Half of the 12 reserve banks now have acted to boost the rate - the interest charged member banks when they borrow from the Reserve system. They include banks at New York, Philadelphia, Chicago, Dallas, Boston and San Francisco.

The increases are expected to spread to the other six banks later.

Santa Monica, Calif. - (UP) - Edward G. Robinson Jr., 25, son of the actor, has been ordered to appear in Superior Court Wednesday on charges of violating probation. Superior Judge Allen T.
