Moss Asks Dulles To Resign Office

Washington—(UPI)—Rep. John E. Moss (D-Calif.) today called for the resignation of acting Secretary of State John Foster Dulles.

Moss said it was "a must" if American interests are to be fully protected abroad.

"Trouble spots across the world cry out to us that we cannot afford the luxury of a part-time secretary of state," he said.

Moss said in a statement that U.S. relations "with far too many nations are rapidly deteriorating for one reason or another."

"Where the nation's interests are at stake," Moss said, "we cannot afford sentimentality. Action should be taken at once. If the President will not take the initiative, then, as a final gesture of self-abnegation and devotion to his country, Mr. Dulles should resign."
