

A joy to cook in . . . a breeze to clean . . . the Westinghouse double built-in ovens. Top oven has a rotisserie for delicious roasting. Lower oven bakes, broils, or roasts. Both are the full 24-inch size, and feature look-in windows to keep the cook COOL and the food HOT (you can turn on an inside light with the door closed). Spread-Even Heaters and Miracle Seal assure perfect results every time. Dial Oven Control, Electric Timer Clock, and Minute Timer on both ovens. New construction and materials make inside cleaning easy . . . brushed chrome exteriors wipe clean in a jiffy. Nutone hood fan captures heat and odors the minute oven door is opened.

Sound-control center is located in the kitchen . . . with speakers in all three bedrooms and on the veranda. You can speak from the kitchen to any of these rooms . . . or any of the rooms can contact another room through the speaker system. It also allows a busy mother to listen to any of the rooms . . . or outdoors . . . to be sure the children are safe. The outdoor speaker acts as a watchman at night. The system is already set to transmit AM and FM radio to all rooms (which have independent volume controls) . . . and has a plug-in for phonograph connection. Handy plug-in for portable telephone is located next to the sound-control center.



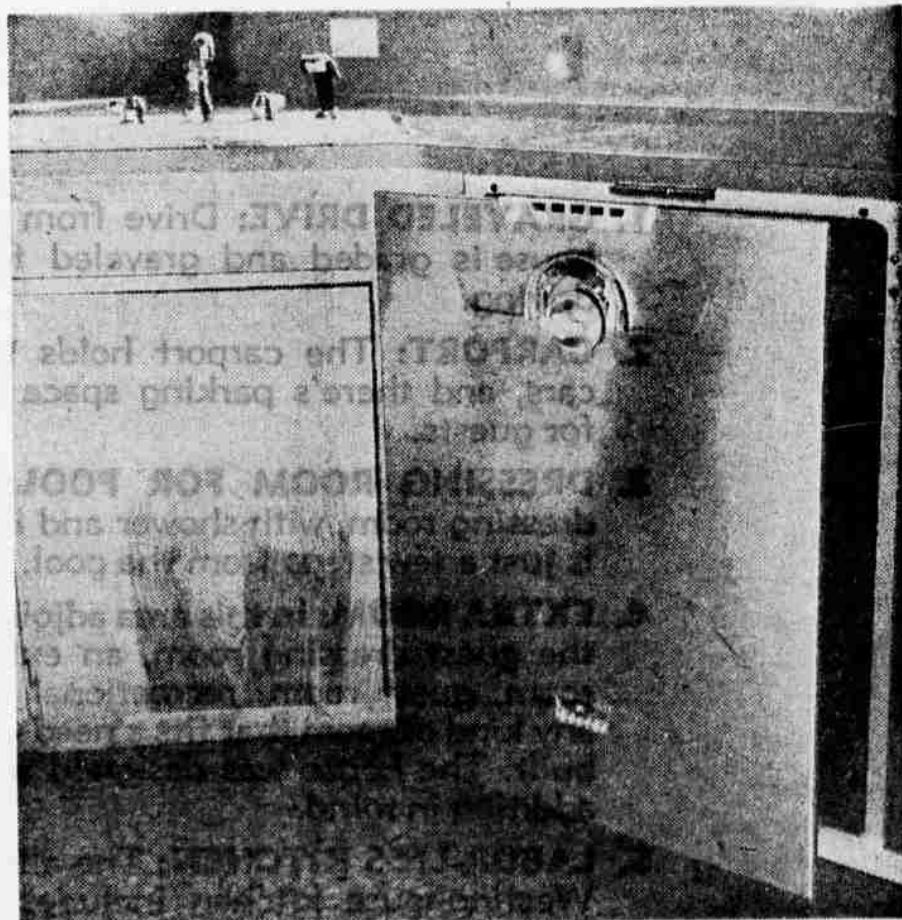
Westinghouse four-unit platform makes range cooking the cleanest and easiest ever. Controls in front are easy and safe to reach. There are five standard heat settings and 1001 in-between settings. Super-Corox unit on left in front gets red hot in 20 seconds—boils water in 60 seconds. Nutone hood fan (which extends over entire range area) captures all cooking heat and odors. Up-front fan controls are easy to reach. The range platform is made of stainless steel and the hood is in a matching finish.

From the in-sink garbage disposer to the serving area next to the stove . . . the built-in Westinghouse all-electric kitchen is designed to make cooking a pleasure for the lady of Hillcrest House II. Her counter space (covered in wear-forever Panelyte) surrounds her—so she never has to take more than a few steps to get what she needs. She has six electric outlets to work her small appliances. Her cupboards open with a touch and close magnetically, and the insides are designed to suit the working area (for example, the shallow spice shelves in the cupboard within easy reach of the range!). And her kitchen overlooks the magnificent Hillcrest House view of the Valley.
