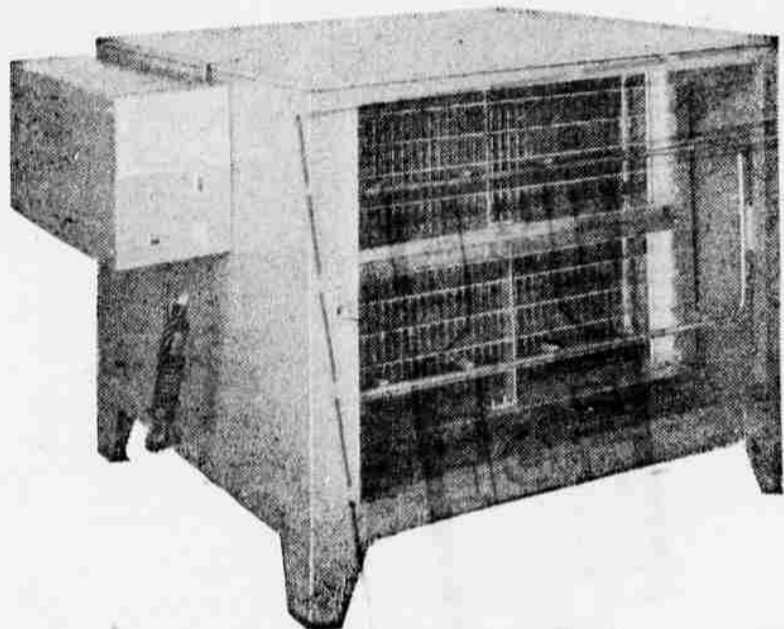

The operation of the Precipitron is actually very simple. Air is taken in through the Precipitron ducts in each room. When it reaches the Precipitron, it receives a positive electrical charge. Further along the way, negative-charged plates collect the dirt, dust, and other impurities the same way a magnet collects nails. Then—at the flick of a switch—the plates are automatically cleaned and the particles washed down the drain! The Precipitron constantly cleans and changes the air throughout the house . . . operating on less electricity than a 25-watt light bulb.
