

Measles Vaccine Believed Found

Los Angeles (AP)—A UCLA Medical School research team reports in a cautiously worded article that it has developed what may prove to be a vaccine against measles—a disease which last year killed twice as many persons as polio.

The findings included a study of 200 hospital patients given the vaccine three years before, a measles epidemic swept the hospital. One-third fewer cases of measles were found among the vaccinated patients, the team reported in the current issue of Virology, a medical journal.

The team, made up of Drs. John M. Adams, David T. Imagawa, Stanley W. Wright and George Tarjan, warned that while the results are encouraging, one test was not enough to prove the vaccine's effectiveness.

The vaccine was produced from live distemper virus cultivated in chicken eggs and limited field tests are now under way.

Unfitness For Appearance

For years, as I have read the descriptions of leprosy in the Bible, I have kept saying to myself, none of this is the leprosy that we know today.

As I remember, there is nothing in the Bible about the commoner symptoms of modern leprosy, such as fingers dropping off, the ulcerated nodules around the nose and the ears, the leonine face, the blindness, and the peculiar spots of skin which are anesthetic to a pin-prick. In the Bible we read that the ancient priests who made the diagnosis of "leprosy" were concerned with practically any type of body abnormality which, according to their ideas, made a man unfit to appear before his God in the court of the temple.

I was just reading an article on the subject by Dr. R. G. Cochrane, adviser on leprosy to the Ministry of Health of Great Britain. He asks, "What should be the Christian attitude towards leprosy?" He says he has been told that the Hebrew word *Tsaraath* means, not leprosy, but "one who is stricken or defiled." In my reading of the Bible, I have been impressed with the repeated mention of the whiteness of "lepers," so much so that my hunch is that most of the people were albinos. Their appearance is striking, but of course, they are perfectly healthy, except for the lack of pigment in their eyes and hair and skin. Dr. Cochrane agrees entirely that "the modern disease of leprosy bears no resemblance to that described in the Bible."

Horror Not Justified

Why do I emphasize these points, and why do I keep pleading for a better attitude on the part of the public toward leprosy and lepers? The reason is that the horror people feel for leprosy is not at all justified by the facts. I know the disease well if only because my father was one of the world's experts on the subject. He never feared catching leprosy. A while ago, when I was visiting in a great leprosy hospital, the physician in charge told me of a man—not a leper—who, years ago, came to the Colony with his leprosy wife, to take care of her. When she died, he married another leprosy woman. She died, and in turn, he was husband to five leprosy women. In spite of this, he never caught the

disease! Obviously, it cannot be very contagious.

Today, with the help of some new drugs, many lepers are being cured and sent home. People must remember that a cured leper is just as safe a person to be around as is a person who never had leprosy. No one need be terribly afraid of him.
