X15 Rocket Due For Another Test

Edwards AFB, Calif. — X15 America's rocket ship X15 was tentatively set for its second captive flight today.

The needle-nosed craft, being readied to carry man to the fringes of space at speeds up to 4,500 miles an hour, was left sitting on the ground here Tuesday when high, gusty winds caused postponement of a scheduled flight.

The 50-foot craft will be carried aloft trucked under the wing of a giant B52 jet bomber in a test of communications with the mother ship. The first such test was cut short March 10 when a radio circuit broke. The craft will remain tethered to the bomber throughout the estimated two-hour test.

He should recognize that many, many practical issues must be considered.

One important issue is whether or not the girl's parents realize that she is contemplating marriage. When a 15-year-old is on the verge of taking such a step, her par-

ents should certainly be aware of it.

We believe that these youngsters must ultimately solve this dilemma for themselves. Consultation with a clergyman of their faith will help them. In many cases, they should not feel that marriage has been forced on them. It is not a punishment or a hiding place in time of panic. The decision must be based on the realities that exist in their own minds and hearts.
