

75 German Measles Cases Are Reported

Seventy-five cases of German measles were reported in Jackson county last week, according to Dr. A. Erin Merkel, public health physician. Of the total, 52 cases were reported in Medford, 18 in Phoenix and 5 in Talent.

There were 92 cases of influenza, 85 of them in Med-

ford, 4 in Phoenix, 2 in Ashland and 1 in Rogue River. Forty-seven cases of measles were reported in Medford, 7 in Phoenix and 5 in Ashland. Other cases of communicable diseases reported to the Jackson county health department included scarlet fever, Central Point 1; infectious hepatitis, Medford 1; whooping cough, Medford 5; strep throat, Medford 1; infectious mononucleosis, Medford 1; scalp ringworm, Medford 1; pneumonia, Medford and Ashland 4 each; and chicken pox, Central Point 10, Medford 9, Ruch 5, Eagle Point 3, and Jacksonville and Applegate 1 each.
