Lake Creek Grange

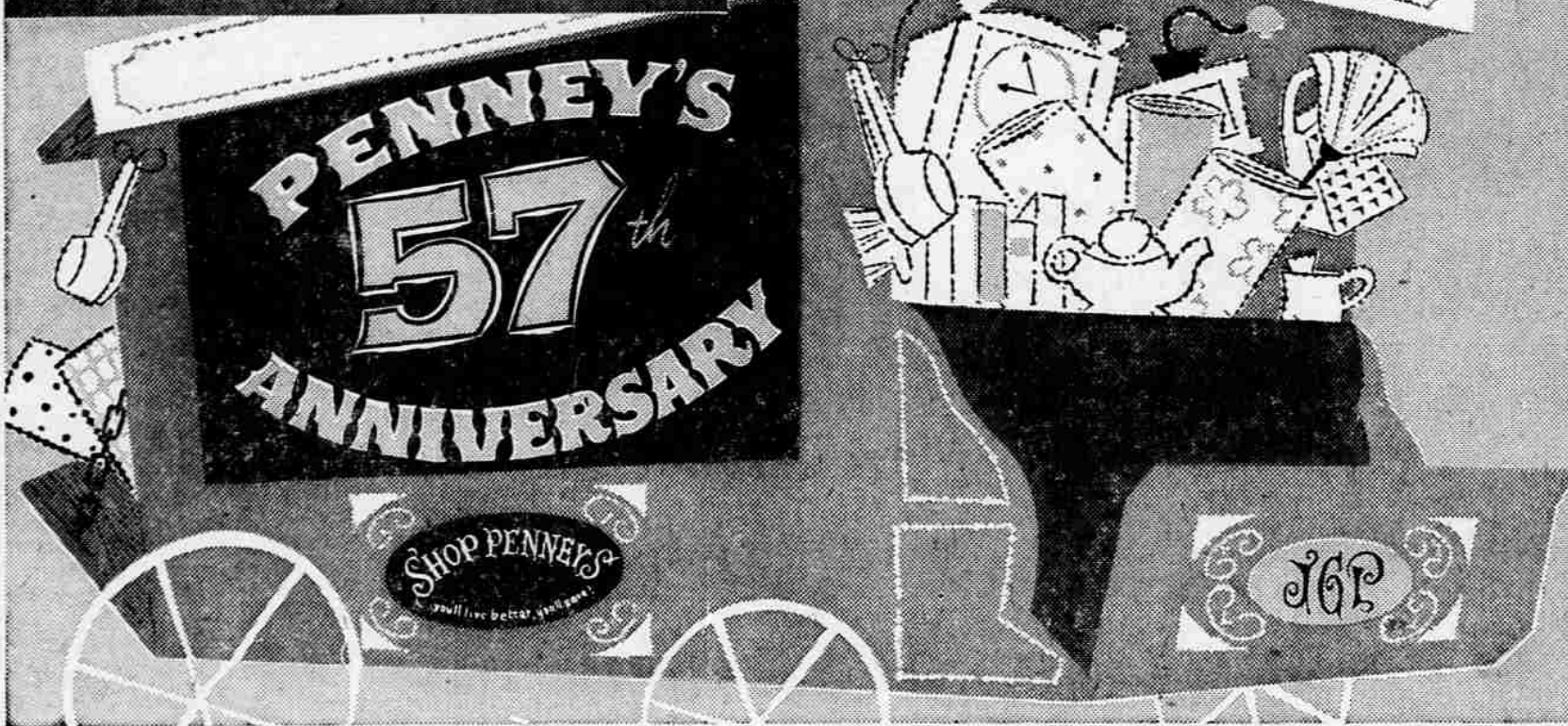
Lake Creek Grange will meet on Friday, April 10, at 8:30 p.m. This is the 31st anniversary of the Grange. The charter was issued in April.

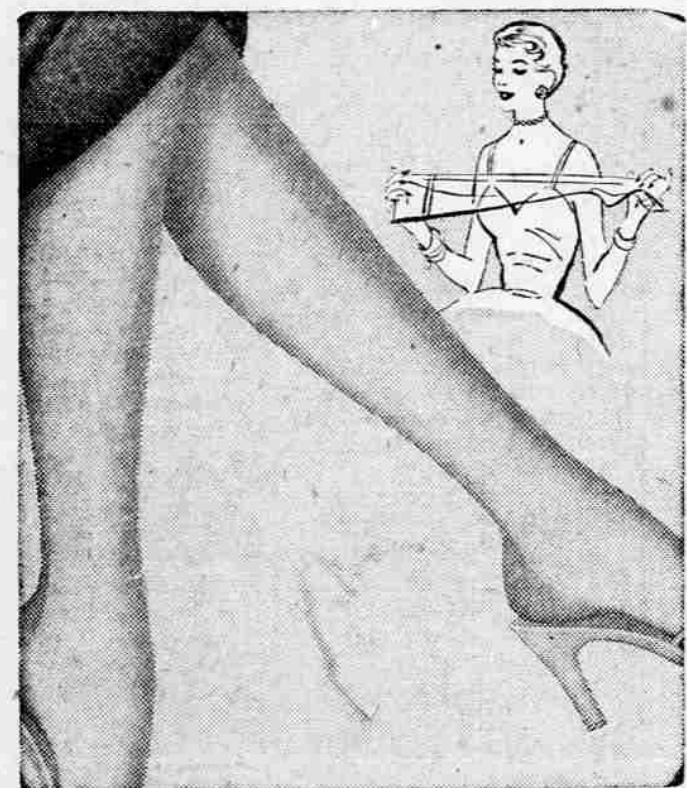
