

4,467 Visitors Are Registered During March at Museum

Jacksonville — A total of 4,467 visitors registered at the Jacksonville museum during March, Miss Mary Hanley, curator, has announced.

The total is an increase of 1,343 over the 3,124 visiting the museum in March, 1958, she said. It was the largest March attendance since the museum opened July 10, 1950 and brought the total number of visitors to 322,265.

Visitors came from 35 states, Canada, England and Indonesia. There were 273 students from Ashland, Central Point, Phoenix, Rogue River Academy, and Jacksonville Hanley said. There also were several groups of Boy Scouts, Girl Scouts, Cub Scouts, Bluebirds and Camp Fire Girls.

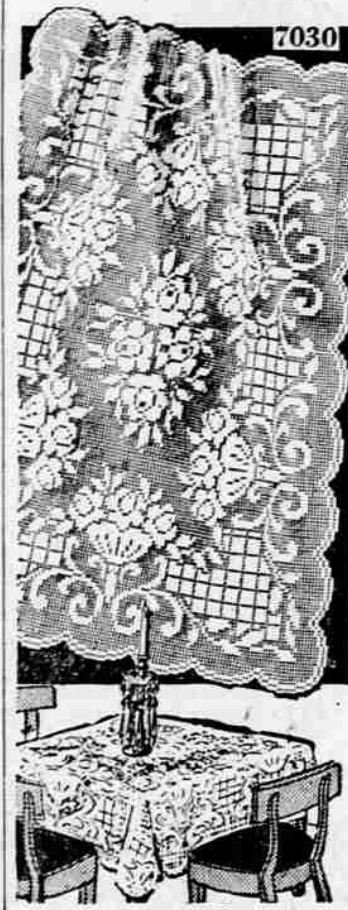

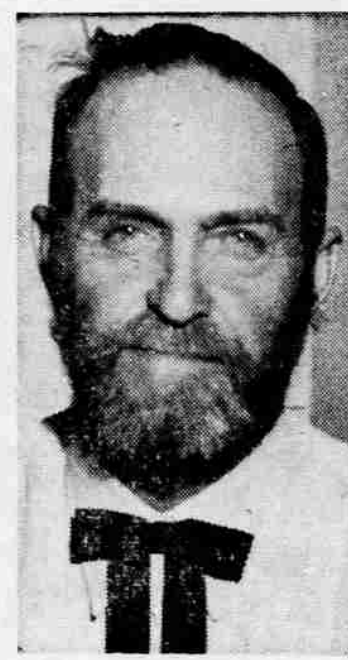

Douglas Fir Seedlings Still Are Available

Farmers and tree farmers wanting Douglas fir or ponderosa pine planting stock can still get good two-year seedlings from the state forester, Salem, according to Carroll Brown, superintendent of Rogue River National forest.

The Oregon state nursery stock was depleted earlier but has been replenished through arrangement with Washington state, Brown said. Although chances of successful planting diminish as the season advances, damp north slopes may still be successfully planted for a few weeks, he added.

String Program Growth Discussed

Growth of the string musical instrument program in the Medford school system and efforts to bring it on par with band were told by John Drysdale, Medford High school orchestra director, at the luncheon meeting of Medford Kiwanis school Wednesday.

Drysdale and Elmer Ayres, McLoughlin High school orchestra and band instructor, played violin duets, and Robert Allen, Medford High student, a violin solo. They were accompanied by Miss LuEla Voegtly, senior high student.

Drysdale reported that there are 39 string instrument players in the high school now compared to nine six years ago. He said that there are 230 students on strings now in the Medford schools. Theme of the speaker was "music for everyone and

everyone for music." He pointed out that "arts keep people from falling off while the world is spinning" but bring the need for people as a whole to participate in the arts to make them live. Things being done musically in schools here are on par

with anything in the state, Drysdale said. Roy Taylor and Dick Lamont were introduced as new Kiwanians.

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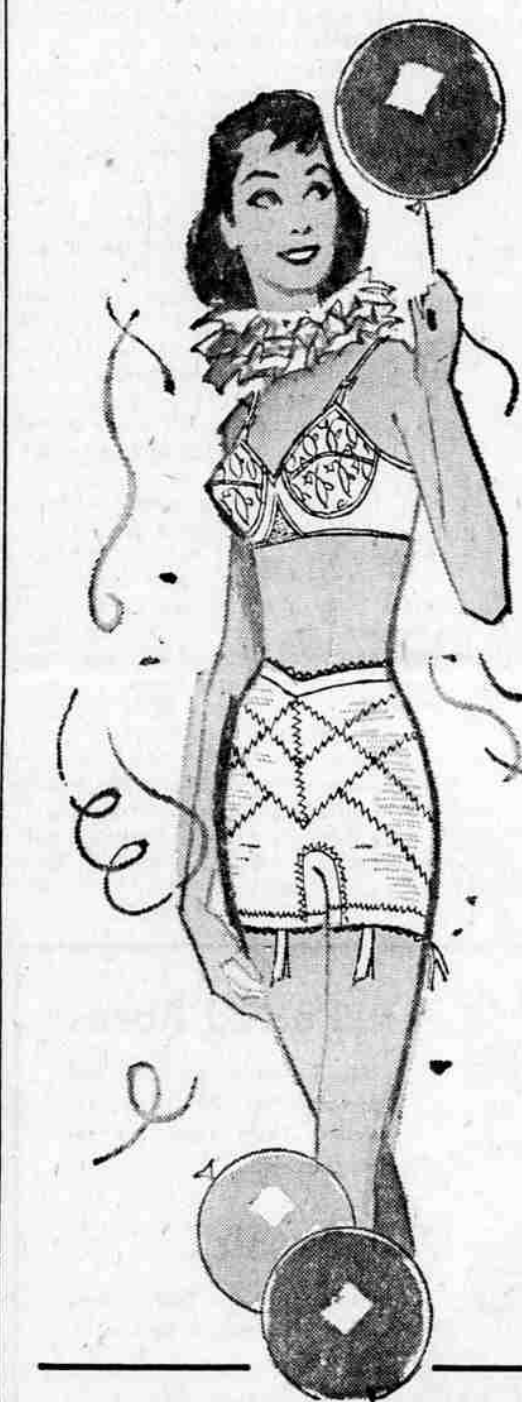
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
