ALL-BRAN MUFFINS

Ever tasted those wonderful old-fashioned bran muffins? Well, here's how you can make 'em yourself... tonight!

INGREDIENTS

- | | |
|--------------------------|-------------------------------|
| 1 cup Kellogg's All-Bran | 1 cup sifted flour |
| 3/4 cup milk | 2-1/2 teaspoons baking powder |
| 1 egg | 1/2 teaspoon salt |
| 1/4 cup soft shortening | 1/4 cup sugar |

- Combine All-Bran and milk. Let stand until most of moisture is taken up. Add egg, shortening; beat well.
- Sift together: flour, baking powder, salt and sugar. Add to the first mixture, stirring only until combined. Fill greased muffin pan 3/4 full.
- Bake in moderately hot oven (400° F.) about 25-30 minutes. Yield: 9 medium size muffins.

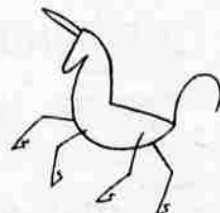
