Pope Proclaims First Two Saints

Vatican City—Pope John XXIII has proclaimed the first two saints of his pontifical realm—Spanish nun Joaquina de Vedruna de Mas and Italian friar Carlo da Sezze. The Pope wore robes of white and gold and the mitre that proclaims him "doctor and chief of the universal church" as he read the Latin canonization formula in a ceremony of ancient splendor. St. Joaquina, who died of cholera in Barcelona in 1854, married and reared a family of nine before her husband died and she became a nun. She was a tireless worker who devoted every waking hour—usually up to 20 hours a day—to practical educational and social work. She was the founder of the Institute of the Carmelite Nuns of Charity.

St. Carlo da Sezze, an almost illegitimate 17th century Franciscan friar, was famed for his mystical visions and prophecies which during his lifetime caused many to believe he already was a saint.
