Joint Committee Raps Cost Planning On State Buildings

Salem —(UPI)— The manner in which state buildings have been constructed in the past has come under heavy fire by the Joint Ways and Means Committee.

It was charged that construction had been started without knowledge of final total costs, resulting in requests for deficiency appropriations to complete buildings.

The discussion developed while the Committee was considering a request from the State Board of Control for a deficiency appropriation of \$1,699,000 for completion of the Dammasch State hospital near Wilsonville.

Sen. Alfred Corbett (D-Portland), co-chairman of the committee, said money previously was appropriated for the first unit of this institution. Then Rep. Vern Cady (D-Burns) said the request for more money indicated poor planning by the Board of Control.

Report Critical
Attention was called by Sen. Dan Thiel (D-Gearhart) to an interim committee re-

port critical of the manner in which state buildings are financed. Rep. Clarence Barton (D-Coquille) said he was all for legislators "to get this off your chest. But it remains that we can't just leave a building half finished. So why all this talk. We have to give the additional money."

The committee then passed the deficiency appropriations.

The Industrial Accident Commission also came under a barrage from the Committee. Rep. Keith Skelton (D-Eugene) declared he had found that the Commission had failed to adopt standards in insurance practices used by insurance companies for the past 25 years.

"The Commission is using obsolete costly methods in processing its claims and I feel a complete investigation of this agency is in order," he said.

OTI Transfer Asked
Corbett said that perhaps this would be the first task to be undertaken by the state fiscal officer expected to be appointed before the end of the session.

The Committee recommended transfer of Oregon Technical Institute from the State Board of Education to the State Board of Higher Education. OTI is located in Klamath Falls.

A bill providing for two additional Supreme Court justices was tabled. However, the Committee approved a bill authorizing the court to utilize up to three pro-tem judges.

The Committee also approved and sent to the House a bill adding the position of corporal to the state police roster.

Hatfield Counsel On Basic School Support Asked
Salem —(UPI)— Rep. Al Fiegel (D-Roseburg) and Sen. Monroe Sweetland (D-Milwaukie) chairman of the House and Senate Education Committees respectively, have urged Gov. Mark Hatfield to give their committees some counsel on the problem of increasing basic school support.

The two said "forceful representations" were being made to the committees that increases in basic school support from the current \$105 level were needed.

"Since your budget message included many fiscal proposals but did not recommend on this major item, are we to assume you do not advise us to provide funds for additional basic school support?" Fiegel and Sweetland asked.

Two bills are being considered by committees to raise basic school support.

"This is probably the largest single item at issue in the proposals requiring new tax revenue, and your recommendations as to the amounts to be budgeted, if any, and the best sources of additional funds are awaited as a guide to our own legislative decisions," the two men wrote the governor.

Sen. President Walter Pearson, who has advocated final adjournment of the Legislature on April 18, expressed disappointment that this appeared impossible.

"But this Senate is the best one I have ever seen," he said, "and I want to compliment the chairman and members of the committees for the splendid work they have done. We will adjourn as soon as possible."
