

Neil R. Allen Dies at Grants Pass

Grants Pass—Neil R. Allen, 64, prominent Grants Pass lawyer and former Oregon department commander for the American Legion, died Monday.

Allen, head of the law firm of Allen, Schultz and Salisbury, was a former chairman of the Oregon Republican Central Committee and for the past 14 years was National Civil Defense chairman for the American Legion. He was a graduate of Stanford University.

Survivors include his widow, Evelyn; a son, Neil C. Allen, of San Francisco, and a daughter, Mrs. Martin Cooper, Mt. Shasta, Calif.

Red China Fills Five Year Plan

Tokyo — UPI — Communist China said Tuesday it has successfully "over-fulfilled" its first five year plan, embracing 1953-57.

The announcement was made by Peiping's State Statistical Bureau and broadcast over Radio Peiping.

It followed a similar announcement by Moscow Monday which said the Soviet Union fulfilled by 105 per cent its first targets to overtake the United States in industrial output.

Prize for First Space Traveler Proposed

Washington — UPI — Rep. Victor L. Anfuso (D-N.Y.) has introduced a bill to award a tax-free \$100,000 prize to the first American to travel in outer space.

The award would be paid to the first man determined to have reached the velocity needed to enter an orbit around the earth. If two or more men reached that velocity at once they would divide the prize.
